Seminole Expressway Ramp Work Next Week at Red Bug Lake Road

OCOE, FL (October 22, 2009) — Repairs to the toll plaza canopy at the Red Bug Lake Road southbound on-ramp to the Seminole Expressway (SR 417) are scheduled several days next week.

Motorists should expect intermittent, daytime closures of the exact-change-required lane, only, October 26-28. As a result, for the safety of workers and motorists, all vehicles must use the SunPass-only lane. While work is occurring, tolls on the ramp will be suspended. SunPass and E-Pass customers will not be charged a toll during the suspension.

Work is scheduled for the following dates and times:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, October 26
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, October 27
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Wednesday, October 28

Tolls will be reinstated daily at 3 p.m., or as soon as work for the day is completed. If the repairs have not been completed by Wednesday due to rain or other delay, October 29 is scheduled as an alternate date to finish the project.

Motorists should not stop in the SunPass-only lane, and proceed with caution through the plaza remaining alert for workers in the area.
