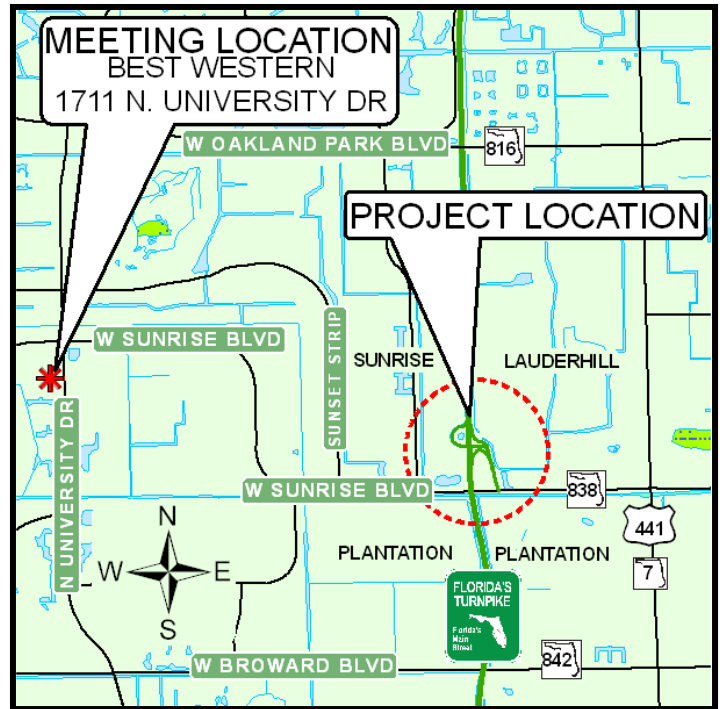




## PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a Public Information Meeting to which all persons are invited. This meeting is being held to afford interested persons the opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed project, Financial Project ID Number: 406103-1, otherwise known as the Sunrise Boulevard Interchange Modification PD&E Study at Turnpike Mile Post 58. The meeting will be held at the Best Western Plantation-Sawgrass, located at 1711 N. University Drive, in Plantation, Florida 33322 on November 2, 2006. The meeting will be conducted as an open house from 5:30 P.M. to 7:30 P.M. at which time the public may review maps, drawings and pertinent information developed by the FDOT. In the event that severe weather or other unforeseen conditions cause the meeting to be postponed, it will be held on the alternate date of November 21, 2006 at the same time and location. This meeting is also being conducted pursuant to the provisions of Rule 14-97, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 335.18, Florida Statutes. This meeting is consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. Right of way acquisition may be required for this project. Potential encroachment on wetlands and floodplains may be given special consideration under Executive Orders 11990 and 11988.



The proposed project is being developed in accordance with the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended. Under Title VI and Title VIII of the Civil Rights Acts, any person(s) or beneficiary who believes they have been subjected to discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability, or familial status may file a written complaint with the FDOT's Equal Opportunity Office, 605 Suwannee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0450.
