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## SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, May 27. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

Due to the Memorial Day Holiday, heavy traffic is anticipated on Florida's Turnpike, from 6 a.m., Friday, May 25 through 10 p.m., Monday, May 28. During peak travel hours, drivers may experience congestion at the Lantana, Three Lakes and Leesburg toll plazas, and at the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce and Fort Drum service plazas.

### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

#### CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT

- Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street, single lane closures; 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- Campbell Drive westbound approaching Florida's Turnpike, double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31; AND 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- Campbell Drive eastbound approaching Florida's Turnpike, double lane closure, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31; AND 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- Campbell Drive eastbound between SW 15700 Block and NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.
- Campbell Drive westbound between NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace and SW 15700 Block, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Campbell Drive, continue north on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Tallahassee Road and then travel west on SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive to enter northbound Turnpike. \*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel north on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway to Campbell Drive. \*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive and continue south on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway. \*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive (Exit 5), continue east on SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and travel south on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue /Tallahassee Road to Campbell Drive. \*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING,  
FROM SOUTHWEST 288<sup>th</sup> STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE to SOUTHWEST 216<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 AND 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street and Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Avenue, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 AND 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
- **SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass, full closure, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - Northbound DETOUR – Travel north on SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road to US 1.
  - Southbound DETOUR – Travel south on SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road, to SW 248<sup>th</sup>/Coconut Palm Drive, then continue south to US 1, continue south to SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Tallahassee Road to SW 288<sup>th</sup>/Biscayne Drive.

- **Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- **Southwest 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Tallahassee Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING FROM EUREKA DRIVE to KILLIAN PARKWAY**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.**
  - **DETOUR – Motorists will be directed through Florida's Turnpike southbound to SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue.**
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184<sup>th</sup> Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.
- **Southwest 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes, including express lanes. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING FROM KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

- **Sunset Drive/ Southwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31 **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.
- **Sunset Drive/ Southwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING FROM SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.
- **Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31 **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through fall 2019. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING FROM BIRD ROAD to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

- **The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has temporarily closed both left turn lanes from westbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to the ramp accessing southbound Turnpike. One lane is scheduled to reopen in summer 2018. This closure will allow crews to reconstruct this intersection. Access to the southbound Turnpike ramp from eastbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will remain open.**
  - **DETOUR – Motorists wishing to enter southbound Turnpike from westbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will continue west on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, then continue south on SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Bird Road and continue east on Bird Road to enter southbound Turnpike. Alternate southern routes include SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Bird Road then continue west to access southbound Turnpike.**
- **Tamiami Trail /Southwest 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, intermittent nighttime single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at midnight. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.**
- **Tamiami Trail /Southwest 8<sup>th</sup> Street westbound and eastbound between Southwest 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, intermittent daytime single lane closures, 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.**
- **Coral Way eastbound and westbound between SW 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31 AND 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.**
- **West Flagler Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 115<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 through Thursday, May 31 AND 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Friday, June 1.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street and at the SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through summer 2020. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

### Florida's Turnpike

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, May 28 **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. ## TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

### Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard

- **Northbound and southbound**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

### Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northwest 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

## FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD TO SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.

- Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closure, 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
- Northbound Turnpike entrance ramp Okeechobee Boulevard, nightly full closure, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. , Tuesday, May 29 through Thursday, May 31.
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard, then south on Jog Road to Southern Boulevard, then continue west to enter northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107). This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. The following ramps will be resurfaced: Southern Boulevard, Jog Road and Okeechobee Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$16.8 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2018.

### ST. LUCIE COUNTY

#### PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike is under reconstruction. All plaza services are being maintained during this time. Motorist should expect changes in traffic patterns and parking and follow all plaza signing. Truck and RV parking is located at the north end of the plaza.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.
