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## SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, January 20. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

#### CAMPBELL DRIVE AND HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/STATE ROAD (SR 821) MODIFICATION PROJECT

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. Monday, January 21 to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, January 22; **AND** 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. Monday, January 21 to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, January 22; **AND** 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.
- **Campbell Drive westbound and eastbound approaching Florida's Turnpike**, continuous double lane closures, Tuesday, January 22 through Sunday, January 27.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. Monday, January 21 to 4:30 a.m. Tuesday, January 21; AND 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.** If necessary to perform work on both northbound entrance ramps, closures will begin at 11 p.m.
  - **DETOUR** – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Campbell Drive, continue north on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/ Tallahassee Road and then travel west on SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive to enter northbound Turnpike.  
**\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. Monday, January 21 to 4:30 a.m. Tuesday, January 21; AND 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.** If necessary to perform work on both northbound entrance ramps, closures will begin at 11 p.m.
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive to SW 157<sup>th</sup> Avenue and continue east on Campbell Drive to access northbound Florida's Turnpike. ***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive (Exit 2) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel north on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway to Campbell Drive. ***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive and continue south on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway. ***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive (Exit 2) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive (Exit 5), continue east on SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and continue south on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue /Tallahassee Road to Campbell Drive. ***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through early 2019. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821)  
FROM SW 288<sup>th</sup> STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE to SW 216<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street and SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.**
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to southbound SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road (Exit 9A) may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. Thursday, January 24 to 5:30 a.m. Friday, January 25.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit southbound Florida's Turnpike at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue (Exit 6), travel north on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Tallahassee Road to SW 268<sup>th</sup> Street and travel east on SW 268<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road.  
***\* Please note, Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to northbound SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road (Exit 9B) will remain open.***

- **SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass may be closed from 9 p.m. Thursday, January 24 to 5:30 a.m. Friday, January 25.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel south on SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road to SW 268<sup>th</sup> Street, travel west on SW 268<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue, travel north on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue to US 1/South Dixie Highway, travel north on US 1/South Dixie Highway to SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street/Coconut Palm Drive and travel east on SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street/Coconut Palm Drive to return to SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road.
- **SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Allapattah Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Tallahassee Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **The north side of SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street/Coconut Palm Drive eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass remains closed and is expected to reopen January 2019. All traffic will be directed to use the south side of SW 248<sup>th</sup> Street/Coconut Palm Drive.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between Biscayne Drive/SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street and Hainlin Mill Road/ SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

**WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA’S TURNPIKE (SR 821)  
FROM EUREKA DRIVE to KILLIAN PARKWAY**

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound or southbound between SW 184<sup>th</sup> Street/Eureka Drive and SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street/ Killian Parkway**, single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **MDX SR 874/Don Shula Expressway northbound between SR 821/MDX SR 874 interchange and SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes, including express lanes, between Eureka Drive/SW 184<sup>th</sup> Street and Killian Parkway /SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street. The Turnpike and S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along qualifying residential

areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

### **WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821) FROM KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single lane closures, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. and both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Kendall Drive/ SW 88<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.
- **Sunset Drive/ SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes, between Killian Parkway/SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street and Sunset Drive/SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street. Sound barrier walls will be built along qualifying residential areas. The Turnpike entrance ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

### **WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821) FROM SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Miller Drive/SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street and Miller Drive/SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street**, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes, between Sunset Drive/SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through fall 2019. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

**WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821)  
FROM BIRD ROAD to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY (SR 836)**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Friday, January 25; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Saturday, January 26.
- **Tamiami Trail/SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent nighttime single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Friday, January 25. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at midnight. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Tamiami Trail/SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent daytime single or double lane closures, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Saturday, January 26.
- **West Flagler Street eastbound and westbound at the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Friday, January 25; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, January 1 Tuesday, January 22 through Saturday, January 26.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes, between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over Florida's Turnpike; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street and at the SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be built along qualifying residential areas. Work also includes road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began summer 2016 and will continue through summer 2020. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

**Florida's Turnpike**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to westbound Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58B) will be closed from 11 p.m. Tuesday, January 22 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, January 23.**
  - **DETOUR –** Motorists traveling on northbound Florida's Turnpike wishing to access westbound Sunrise Boulevard will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard (Exit 62), continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7 and continue south on US 441/SR 7 to access Sunrise Boulevard.

***\*Please note, Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to eastbound Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58A) will remain open.***

## WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821) FROM I-75 to TURNPIKE MAINLINE (SR 91)

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.
- **NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Palm Avenue northbound and southbound between Miramar Parkway and NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street/Honey Hill Drive will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24.**
  - **Northbound DETOUR – Motorists on northbound NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Palm Avenue wishing to continue north will be directed to NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street/Honey Hill Drive, travel west on NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street/Honey Hill Drive to NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Red Road, travel north on NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Red Road to Miramar Parkway and travel east on Miramar Parkway to access NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Palm Avenue.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to eight lanes. Work includes intersection improvements at Red Road/NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue and University Drive/ NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction began in September 2018 will continue through summer 2022. Approximate cost: \$143 million.

**SUNRISE BOULEVARD (SR 838) AND FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE  
MODIFICATION PROJECT (SR 91)**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Thursday, January 24. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

**ALL ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) PHASE 5A  
FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE MAINLINE (SR 91) FROM I-595 TO SOUTH OF LANTANA TOLL PLAZA**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between south of Commercial Boulevard and south of Sawgrass Expressway**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 21 through Thursday, January 24; **AND** 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25.
- **Commercial Boulevard eastbound and westbound between Rock Island Road and east of SR 7/US 441**, single lane closures, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, January 22 through Friday, January 25. *\*Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.*

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to continue with the complete conversion of the Turnpike Mainline to an All Electronic Toll (AET) collection system. The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements, curb & gutter, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, MSE walls, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Florida's Turnpike from I-595 (milepost 54) to south of Lantana Toll Plaza (milepost 88) for 34 miles in Broward and Palm Beach Counties. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$20.4 million and work will continue through summer 2020.

#### **Florida's Turnpike**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from Milepost 153 to Milepost 169. This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings.
