FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, October 21. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE

- Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from SW 112th Avenue/Allapattah Road, single lane closures, 10:30 p.m. Monday, October 22 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, October 23.
- Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from SW 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive, single lane closures, 10:30 p.m. Wednesday, October 24 to 5 a.m. Thursday, October 25.
- Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to SW 40th Street/Bird Road, single lane closures, 10:30 p.m. Tuesday, October 23 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, October 24.

CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT

- Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of SW 288th Street, single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of SW 288th Street, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Sunday, October 28.

- **Campbell Drive westbound and eastbound approaching Florida’s Turnpike**, continuous double lane closures, Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.** If necessary to close both northbound entrance ramps from Campbell Drive, closures will begin at 11 p.m.
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Campbell Drive, continue north on SW 137th Avenue/ Tallahassee Road and then travel west on SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive to enter northbound Turnpike.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.** If necessary to close both northbound entrance ramps from Campbell, closures will begin at 11 p.m.
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive to SW 157th Avenue and continue east on Campbell Drive to access northbound Florida’s Turnpike.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive (Exit 2) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel north on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway to Campbell Drive.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive and continue south on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive (Exit 2) may be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive (Exit 5), continue east on SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and continue south on SW 137th Avenue /Tallahassee Road to Campbell Drive.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida’s Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152nd Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30th Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING
FROM SW 288th STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE to SW 216th STREET**

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound between SW 288th Street and SW 216th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.

- **SW 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass, northbound and southbound, will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Wednesday, October 24 and Thursday, October 25.**
 - Northbound DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive, continue north on US 1/S. Dixie Highway and then continue east on SW 280th Street to return to SW 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road.
 - Southbound DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on SW 272nd Street, continue south on US 1/S. Dixie Highway and then continue east on SW 288th Street to return to SW 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road.
- * ***Please note, these closures will not occur concurrently.***
- **SW 112th Avenue/Allapattah Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137th Avenue and SW 112th Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING FROM EUREKA DRIVE to KILLIAN PARKWAY

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound or southbound between SW 184th Street/Eureka Drive and SW 104th Street/Killian Parkway, single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.** One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway northbound between SR 821/SR 874 interchange and SW 104th Street/Killian Parkway, single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.** One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **SW 152nd Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.**
- **SW 117th Avenue northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.**
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes, including express lanes. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING
FROM KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. and both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Kendall Drive/ SW 88th Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Sunset Drive/ SW 72nd Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING
FROM SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/SW 72nd Street and Bird Road/SW 40th Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Miller Drive/SW 56th Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117th Avenue and SW 118th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.
- **Bird Road/SW 40th Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117th Avenue and SW 122nd Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.
- **SW 117th Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/SW 40th Street and Miller Drive/SW 56th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through fall 2019. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING
FROM BIRD ROAD to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/SW 40th Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to NW 12th Street will be closed from 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, October 23 and Wednesday, October 24.**
 - **DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 8th Street (Exit 25), continue east to SW 107th Avenue and continue north to access NW 12th Street.**
- **Coral Way/SW 24th Street eastbound and westbound between SW 114th Avenue and SW 122nd Avenue**, intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Friday, October 26; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Saturday, October 27.
- **Tamiami Trail/SW 8th Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent nighttime single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Friday, October 26. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at midnight. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Tamiami Trail/SW 8th Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent daytime single lane closures, 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.
- **West Flagler Street eastbound and westbound between SW 115th Avenue and SW 118th Avenue**, intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Friday, October 26; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Saturday, October 27.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24th Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8th Street and at the SW 8th Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through summer 2020. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

BROWARD COUNTY

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - **DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard and continue south on US 441/ SR 7 to the westbound ramp to I-595 and follow the signs to return to the southbound Turnpike.**
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between south of Griffin Road and I-595**, intermittent rolling single lane closures, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Wednesday, October 24.

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between south of Sunrise Boulevard and I-595**, intermittent rolling single lane closures, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Thursday, October 25.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

- **All southbound lanes of Florida's Turnpike between Red Road and Snake Creek Canal will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, 29 and Tuesday, October 30.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Red Road (Exit 43), continue north on Red Road to Miramar Parkway, continue west on Miramar Parkway to I-75 and then continue south on I-75 to access southbound Florida's Turnpike (Exit 5).
- **Northbound Florida's Turnpike ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39) will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, October 24 to 5 a.m. Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists wishing to use the northbound Florida's Turnpike ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39) will be directed to exit at US 27/Okeechobee Road (Exit 35), continue southeast on US 27/Okeechobee Road to NW 138th Street and continue northeast on NW 138th Street to Hialeah Garden Boulevard to access northbound entrance ramp to I-75.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Okeechobee Road and I-75 interchange**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between I-75 interchange and Red Road**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to northbound I-75**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. Sunday, October 21 to 6 a.m. Monday, October 22.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. WIDENING OF THE HOMESTEAD EXTENSION OF THE FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE (SR 821) FROM I-75 to TURNPIKE MAINLINE (SR 91)

- No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four to eight lanes. Work includes intersection improvements at NW 57th Avenue/Red Road and NW 27th Avenue/University Drive. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction began in September 2018 will continue through summer 2022. Approximate cost: \$143 million.

TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from westbound Sunrise Boulevard will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Sunrise Boulevard to SR 7/US 441, continue south to the westbound ramp to I-595 and follow the signs to access southbound Turnpike. As an alternate route, motorists should be aware that the new AET southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Sunrise Boulevard will remain open and can be used to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard (Exit 62), continue east to SR 7/US 441 and continue south to Sunrise Boulevard. As an alternate route, motorists familiar with the area can exit at Griffin Road or I-595, continue east to SR 7/US 441 and continue north to access Sunrise Boulevard.
- **Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue**, single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47th Avenue and NW 56th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

ALL ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) PHASE 5A FROM I-595 TO SOUTH OF LANTANA TOLL PLAZA

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between south of Commercial Boulevard to south of Atlantic Boulevard**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Sunrise Boulevard, continue east on Sunrise Boulevard and continue north on SR 7 to access Commercial Boulevard.
**Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Commercial Boulevard will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - **DETOUR** – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Commercial Boulevard, continue south on SR 7/US 441 and continue west on Sunrise Boulevard to enter southbound Turnpike.
* Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Commercial Boulevard eastbound and westbound between Rock Island Road and east of SR 7/US 441**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 p.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26. *Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.
- **Atlantic Boulevard eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26. *Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.
- **Atlantic Boulevard eastbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25. *Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.
- **Sample Road eastbound and westbound between Tradewinds Park Road and NW 27th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26. *Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.
- **Coconut Creek Parkway eastbound and westbound between Coconut Creek Boulevard and NW 27th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 22 through Friday, October 26.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to continue with the complete conversion of the Turnpike Mainline to an All Electronic Toll (AET) collection system. The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements, curb & gutter, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, MSE walls, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Florida's Turnpike from I-595 (milepost 54) to south of Lantana Toll Plaza (milepost 88) for 34 miles in Broward and Palm Beach Counties. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$20.4 million and work will continue through summer 2020.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT
FROM NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD TO SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, October 21 to 5:30 a.m. Monday, October 22; **AND** 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, October 22 through Thursday, October 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Okeechobee Boulevard will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**

- DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard and continue south on Jog Road to access southbound Florida’s Turnpike.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Okeechobee Boulevard will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Jog Road (Exit 98) and continue west on Jog Road to access Okeechobee Boulevard.
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Okeechobee Boulevard will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Southern Boulevard (Exit 97), continue east on Southern Boulevard, and continue north on Jog Road to access Okeechobee Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida’s Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107). This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. The following ramps will be resurfaced: Southern Boulevard, Jog Road and Okeechobee Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$16.8 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2018.

FLORIDA’S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT FROM SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY TO SOUTH OF INDIANTOWN ROAD

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound at various locations between south of Beeline Highway and south of Indiantown Road, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, October 23 through Thursday, October 25.**
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound at various locations between south of Indiantown Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday, October 23 through Thursday, October 25.**
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Beeline Highway will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, October 19 to 9 a.m., Sunday, October 21.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Beeline Highway, travel north on SR 809/Military Trail and travel west on PGA Boulevard to access northbound Turnpike.
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Beeline Highway will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, October 19 to 9 a.m., Sunday, October 21.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Beeline Highway, travel north on SR 809/Military Trail and travel west on PGA Boulevard to access southbound Turnpike.
- **One lane of southbound Florida’s Turnpike between PGA Boulevard to Beeline Highway will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, October 19 to 7 a.m. Saturday, October 20 and then from 10 p.m. Saturday, October 20 to 9 a.m. Sunday, October 21.**
- **One lane of northbound Florida’s Turnpike between PGA Boulevard to Beeline Highway will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, October 19 to 9 a.m. Saturday, October 20 and then from 10 p.m. Saturday, October 20 to 9 a.m. Sunday, October 21.**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Beeline Highway will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, October 26 to 9 a.m., Sunday, October 28.**
 - **DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at PGA Boulevard (Exit 109), continue east to SR 809/Military Trail and continue south to Beeline Highway.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from south of Beeline Highway to south of Indiantown Road. This project also includes improvements to signing, lighting and pavement markings. The following ramp will be resurfaced: PGA Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$11 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2019.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE INTERCHANGE INTERIM INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- **Port St. Lucie Boulevard westbound at the intersection of Port St. Lucie Boulevard and Bayshore Drive, single lane closure, 10: 30 p.m. Sunday, October 21 to 6 a.m. Monday, October 22.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike will be constructing improvements designed to help improve traffic flow at the intersection of SW Bayshore Boulevard and Port St. Lucie Boulevard. Work includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting, landscaping and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.5 million and construction is expected to continue through late 2018.

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike is under reconstruction. All plaza services are being maintained during this time. Motorist should expect changes in traffic patterns and parking and follow all plaza signing. Truck and RV parking is located at the north end of the plaza. Bus parking only is now available on the east and west sides adjacent to the new restaurant building.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.

RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS (MP 153-169)

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between north of Fort Pierce/SR 70 to mile post 169, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 21 through Thursday, October 25.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from north of Fort Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 152) to mile post 169. This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$35.9 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2019.
