## SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, July 15. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

#### TURNPIKE MAINTENANCE

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp at SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street (Toll Plaza)**, intermittent single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. Wednesday, July 18 to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street Toll Plaza**, intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m., Wednesday, July 18 to 5 a.m., Thursday, July 19.

#### CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Campbell Drive westbound and eastbound approaching Florida's Turnpike**, double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Sunday, July 15 through Sunday, July 22; AND 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, July 15 through Sunday, July 22.
- **Campbell Drive eastbound between SW 15700 Block and NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately one month to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area; **AND** double lane closure, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Sunday, July 22.

- **Campbell Drive westbound between NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace and SW 15700 Block**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately one month to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area; **AND** double lane closure, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Sunday, July 22.
- **Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will open the new northbound entrance ramp at Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue on Wednesday, July 18, and will temporarily close the current northbound entrance ramp until the end of Summer 2018.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Campbell Drive to SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to access the new Campbell Drive entrance ramps.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel north on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway to Campbell Drive.  
***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive and continue south on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway.  
***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive (Exit 5), continue east on SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and travel south on SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue /Tallahassee Road to Campbell Drive.  
***\*Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.***

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING,  
FROM SW 288<sup>th</sup> STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE to SW 216<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- No lane closures scheduled.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING  
FROM EUREKA DRIVE to KILLIAN PARKWAY**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between SW 184<sup>th</sup> Street/Eureka Drive and SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single and double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway northbound between SR 821/SR 874 interchange and SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes, including express lanes. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING  
FROM KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. The first lane closes at 10 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Sunset Drive/ SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Kendall Drive/ SW 88<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING  
FROM SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, double lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. If necessary, the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20; **AND** 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street and Miller Drive/SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20; **AND** 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Miller Drive/SW 56<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through fall 2019. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING  
FROM BIRD ROAD to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, double lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. If necessary, a second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has temporarily closed both left turn lanes from westbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to the ramp accessing southbound Turnpike. One lane is scheduled to reopen in summer 2018. This closure will allow crews to reconstruct this intersection. Access to the southbound Turnpike ramp from eastbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will remain open.**
  - **DETOUR –** Motorists wishing to enter southbound Turnpike from westbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will continue west on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street to SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, then continue south on SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Bird Road and continue east on Bird Road to enter southbound Turnpike. Alternate southern routes include SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Bird Road then continue west to access southbound Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to eastbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed from 11:30 p.m. Sunday, July 15 to 5 a.m. Monday, July 16.**
  - **DETOUR–** Motorists will be detoured to exit southbound Turnpike at Bird Road (Exit 23) then travel north on SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

- **West Flagler Street eastbound and westbound between SW 115<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19; **AND** 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **Tamiami Trail /SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent nighttime single or double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Friday, July 20. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at midnight. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Tamiami Trail /SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, intermittent daytime single lane closures, 11 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between SW 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, intermittent single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes, including express lanes. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street and at the SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through summer 2020. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

## **BROWARD COUNTY**

### **TURNPIKE MAINTENANCE**

- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard (Toll Plaza) will be closed from 10:30 p.m. Monday, July 16 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 17.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Atlantic Boulevard, travel east on Atlantic Boulevard to University Drive and then travel south on University Drive to Commercial Boulevard.
- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound entrance ramp from US 441/SR 7 (Toll Plaza) will be closed overnight from 10:30 p.m. Thursday, July 19 to 5 a.m. Friday, July 20.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel south on US 441/SR 7 to Sample Road, travel west on Sample Road to University Drive, and then travel north on University Drive to access the Sawgrass Expressway.

### **75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION**

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Red Road and Snake Creek Canal, full closure, 11 p.m. Monday, July 16 to 6 a.m. Tuesday, July 17.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at Red Road (Exit 43), travel north on Red Road to Miramar Parkway, then travel west on Miramar Parkway to I-75 and then continue south on I-75 to exit to southbound Turnpike (Exit 5).

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. ## **TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS**

### ***Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard***

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at the I-595 interchange will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - DETOUR- Motorists will be directed to exit the Turnpike at I-595, travel east on I-595 to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike. As an alternate route, motorists can also exit at Griffin Road (Exit 53), travel east on Griffin Road to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramps from eastbound and westbound I-595 will also be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - DETOUR- Motorists on I-595 will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 (Exit 9A), travel northbound on US 441/SR 7 to Sunrise Boulevard where they will be able to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Sunrise Boulevard eastbound and westbound between NW 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

## **ALL ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) PHASE 5A FROM I-595 TO SOUTH OF LANTANA TOLL PLAZA**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between south of Commercial Boulevard to Sunrise Boulevard**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 16 through Thursday, July 19 and Sunday, July 22.

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, July 16 through Thursday, July 19 and Sunday, July 22.
- **Commercial Boulevard eastbound and westbound between Rock Island Road and east of SR 7/US 441**, single lane closures, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.  
\*Please note, this closure will not affect the entrance or exit ramps.
- **Atlantic Boulevard eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **Sample Road eastbound and westbound between Tradewinds Park Road and NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.
- **Coconut Creek Parkway eastbound and westbound between Coconut Creek Boulevard and NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, July 16 through Friday, July 20.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary to continue with the complete conversion of the Turnpike Mainline to an All Electronic Toll (AET) collection system. The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements, curb & gutter, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, MSE walls, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Florida's Turnpike from I-595 (mile post 54) to south of Lantana Toll Plaza (mile post 88) for 34 miles in Broward and Palm Beach Counties. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$20.4 million and work will continue through summer 2020.

### **PALM BEACH COUNTY**

#### **FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD TO SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway**, single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 15 to 5:30 a.m. Monday, July 16; **AND** 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, July 16 through Thursday, July 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Okeechobee Boulevard, nightly full closure, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 15 through Thursday, July 19.**
  - **DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Okeechobee Boulevard, then south on Jog Road to Southern Boulevard, then continue west to enter northbound Florida's Turnpike.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107). This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. The following ramps will be resurfaced: Southern Boulevard, Jog Road and Okeechobee Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$16.8 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2018.

## ST. LUCIE COUNTY

### PORT ST. LUCIE INTERCHANGE INTERIM INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- No lane closures scheduled.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike will be constructing improvements designed to help improve traffic flow at the intersection of SW Bayshore Boulevard and Port St. Lucie Boulevard. Work includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting, landscaping and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$1.5 million and construction is expected to continue through late 2018.

### PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike** is under reconstruction. All plaza services are being maintained during this time. Motorist should expect changes in traffic patterns and parking and follow all plaza signing. Truck and RV parking is located at the north end of the plaza.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking
