SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, June 25. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

Florida's Turnpike

- **Allapattah Toll Plaza southbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 9:30 p.m. Tuesday, June 27 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 26.
- **Allapattah Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10:30 p.m. Tuesday, June 27 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 26.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152nd Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30th Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
SOUTHWEST 288th STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE (Exit 5) to SOUTHWEST 216th STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Southwest 216th Street and Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288th Street and Southwest 216th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137th Avenue and SW 112th Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
EUREKA DRIVE (Exit 13) to KILLIAN PARKWAY (Milepost 20)**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured through Florida's Turnpike southbound to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue.
- **Southwest 120th Street – All eastbound lanes at the Turnpike interchange will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Wednesday, June 28 and Thursday, June 29.**
 - DETOUR – Eastbound traffic will be directed to travel north on Southwest 122nd Avenue to Southwest 104th Street, travel east on Southwest 104th Street and continue south on Southwest 117th Avenue to Southwest 120th Street.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104th Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. If necessary two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.

- **Southwest 168th Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Southwest 152nd Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Southwest 120th Street**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion in early 2017. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD (Exit 23)

- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street – All eastbound lanes of Southwest 56th Avenue will be closed around-the-clock beginning at 6 a.m. and ending at 5 p.m. on Sunday, June 25. Closures will occur again from 10:30 p.m. Monday, June 26 to 5 a.m. on Tuesday, June 27.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to travel south on SW 127th Avenue, then travel east on Sunset Drive and north on SW 117th Avenue to return to Miller Drive.
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street – All westbound lanes of Southwest 56th Avenue will be closed from 10:30 p.m. Monday, June 26 to 5 a.m. on Tuesday, June 27.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to travel south on SW 117th Avenue, then travel west on Sunset Drive and north on SW 127th Avenue to return to Miller Drive.

- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 118th Avenue**, single lane closures, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., Sunday, June 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72nd Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street**, Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 122nd Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Friday, June 30.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Friday, June 30.
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 118th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Friday, June 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES BIRD ROAD (Exit 23) to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 (Exit 26)

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street**, Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express Lanes will also be constructed. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24th Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8th Street and at the SW 8th Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

NW 199th STREET BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

- **Northbound entry ramp from NW 199th Street, continuous single lane closure**, Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.

- **Northbound exit ramp to NW 199th Street, continuous single lane closure**, Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at NW 199th Street**, Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29. The first lane closes at 10 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 11:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project entails bridge painting and rehabilitation to the entrance and exit ramp to Northwest 199 Street in Miami Gardens. Work will begin in February 2017 and will continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$2.6 million.

BROWARD COUNTY

TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

Sawgrass Expressway

- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound exit ramp to Commercial Boulevard will be closed from 11 p.m. Monday, June 26 to 5 a.m. Tuesday, June 27.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to exit southbound Sawgrass Expressway at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8), travel east on Atlantic Boulevard and south on University Drive to Commercial Boulevard.
- **Sawgrass Expressway northbound exit ramp to SR7/US 441 will be closed from 11 p.m. Tuesday, June 27 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, June 28.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to exit southbound SR7/US 441 (Exit 18A) and make a U-turn to continue to SR7/US 441.

Florida's Turnpike

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Glades Road and Boynton Beach Boulevard**, Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29. The first lane closes at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

Florida's Turnpike

- **The ramp from northbound Turnpike to I-75 northbound will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 27 through Saturday, July 1.**

- **DETOUR** – Exit at Okeechobee Road then continue east on NW 138th Street, then travel north to Hialeah Gardens Boulevard and take the entrance ramp to northbound I-75.
- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

Florida’s Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard

- **Northbound and southbound, double lane closures**, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47th Avenue and Northwest 56th Avenue

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY CANAL REVETMENT PROJECT

- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound exit ramp to University Drive**, one lane closed through July 2017. The ramp will remain open to traffic.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike Enterprise is continuing a construction project to repair and stabilize canal embankment slopes in the City of Parkland on the north side of the Sawgrass Expressway between Coral Springs Drive and University Drive; and between University Drive and Riverside Drive. It is estimated that the second and third phases of the project will cost about \$8 million and be complete in July 2017.

PALM BEACH COUNTY

GLADES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

- **The northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, June 25 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 26. If needed to complete this work, this ramp will also close nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29.**
 - **DETOUR–** Motorists will be detoured to exit northbound Turnpike at Sample Road (Exit 69), travel east on Sample Road and north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.
- **The northbound exit ramp to Glades Road may be closed intermittently for up to 5 minutes at 11 a.m. on Thursday, June 29 and Friday, June 30 to relocate a crane.**
- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 26 through Thursday, June 29; AND 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 25 through Thursday, June 29.
- **Glades Road westbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday, June 24.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Glades Road and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from the northbound Turnpike to Glades Road to two lanes, adding an additional right turn lane from the Turnpike exit ramp to westbound Glades Road, and adding an auxiliary lane on the northbound Turnpike. Work also includes painting the existing Turnpike bridge over Glades Road and improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$8.3 million and construction is expected to be completed in summer 2018.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike** is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is open, along with a new fuel station. Truck parking is also now available at the north end of the plaza.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.
