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## SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, August 13. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

### TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

#### Florida's Turnpike

- **Bird Road Toll Plaza northbound**, partial lane closure, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, August 14 through Tuesday, August 29.
- **Bird Road Toll Plaza southbound**, partial lane closure, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, August 14 through Tuesday, August 29.
- **Miramar Toll Plaza southbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9:30 p.m. Tuesday, August 15 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, August 16.
- **NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue Toll Plaza southbound entrance ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Wednesday, August 16 to 5 a.m. Thursday, August 17.
- **NW 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 11 p.m. Wednesday, August 16 to 5 a.m. Thursday, August 17.

### MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

## **CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT**

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Campbell Drive westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.
- **Campbell Drive eastbound between SW 15700 Block and NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months in order to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

## **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SOUTHWEST 288<sup>th</sup> STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE (Exit 5) to SOUTHWEST 216<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Street and Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street and Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

## **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES EUREKA DRIVE (Exit 13) to KILLIAN PARKWAY (Milepost 20)**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday August 17.**
  - **DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured through Florida's Turnpike southbound to Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue.**

- **Southwest 120th Street – All westbound lanes at the Turnpike interchange will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday August 17.**
  - DETOUR – Westbound traffic will be directed to travel north on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, travel west on Killian Parkway and continue south on Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Southwest 120<sup>th</sup> Street.
- **Southwest 120th Street – All eastbound lanes at the Turnpike interchange will be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday August 17.**
  - DETOUR – Eastbound traffic will be directed to travel north on Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to Southwest 104<sup>th</sup> Street, travel east on Southwest 104<sup>th</sup> Street and continue south on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Southwest 120<sup>th</sup> Street.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184<sup>th</sup> Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **Southwest 168<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.
- **Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.
- **Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.
- **Southwest 120<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion in early 2017. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **All lanes southbound on Florida’s Turnpike at Bird Road will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, August 14 through Thursday, August 17.**
  - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to exit at Bird Road (Exit 23), travel west on Bird to SW 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue, continue south on SW 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Kendall Drive and travel east on Kendall Drive to enter southbound Florida’s Turnpike. Motorists on west Bird road can travel south on SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Kendall Drive to enter southbound Florida’s Turnpike.
- **The southbound Turnpike entrance ramp from Bird Road will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, August 14 through Thursday, August 17.**

- **DETOUR – Bird Road traffic will be directed to travel west on Bird Road to SW 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue, continue south on SW 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Kendall Drive and travel east on Kendall Drive to enter southbound Florida’s Turnpike.**
- **Northbound or southbound Florida’s Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive, single and double lane closures, Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD (Exit 23)**

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street, Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.**
- **Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17; AND 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.**
- **Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.**
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.**

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES BIRD ROAD (Exit 23) to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 (Exit 26)**

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street, Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.**

- **Tamiami Trail /Southwest 8<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 114<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, multiple lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Flagler Street eastbound and westbound between Northwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express Lanes will also be constructed. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street and at the SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

### **NW 199<sup>th</sup> STREET BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT**

- **Northbound entry ramp from NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street, continuous single lane closure**, Sunday, August 13 through Sunday, August 17.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project entails bridge painting and rehabilitation to the entrance and exit ramp to Northwest 199 Street in Miami Gardens. Work will begin in February 2017 and will continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$2.6 million.

### **BROWARD COUNTY**

#### **TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE**

##### **Sawgrass Expressway**

- **Sawgrass Expressway northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunrise Boulevard and University Drive**, Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. The first lane closes at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

##### **Florida's Turnpike**

- **Cypress Creek Toll Plaza northbound**, full lane closure, 10:30 p.m. Wednesday, August 16 to 5 a.m. Thursday, August 17. Traffic will be diverted to the cash lanes for the duration of this closure.

#### **75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION**

##### **Florida's Turnpike**

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. ## **TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS**

### **Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard**

- **Northbound and southbound**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

### **Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northwest 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue**

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

## **PALM BEACH COUNTY**

### **GLADES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

- **The northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.; Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17.**
  - **DETOUR–** Motorists will be detoured to exit northbound Turnpike at Sample Road (Exit 69), travel east on Sample Road and north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.
- **Glades Road westbound approaching the Turnpike, nightly** single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 13 through Thursday, August 17. A second lane may close beginning at 10 p.m.

- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, daily single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, August 14 through Friday, August 18.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Glades Road and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from the northbound Turnpike to Glades Road to two lanes, adding an additional right turn lane from the Turnpike exit ramp to westbound Glades Road, and adding an auxiliary lane on the northbound Turnpike. Work also includes painting the existing Turnpike bridge over Glades Road and improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$8.3 million and construction is expected to be completed in summer 2018.

### **ST. LUCIE COUNTY**

#### **PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION**

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike** is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is open, along with a new fuel station. Truck parking is also now available at the north end of the plaza.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.

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
