## **SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY**

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, May 21. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

### **MIAMI-DADE COUNTY**

#### **TOLL EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE**

##### **Florida's Turnpike**

- **Coral Reef Drive Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 23.
- **Coral Reef Drive Toll Plaza southbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 23.
- **US 441/ SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street Toll Plaza northbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, May 25.
- **US 441/ SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street Toll Plaza southbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, May 25.

## **CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT**

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, May 22 through Thursday, May 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30<sup>th</sup> Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SOUTHWEST 288<sup>th</sup> STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE (Exit 5) to SOUTHWEST 216<sup>th</sup> STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Street and Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288<sup>th</sup> Street and Southwest 216<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288<sup>th</sup> Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216<sup>th</sup> Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES EUREKA DRIVE (Exit 13) to KILLIAN PARKWAY (Milepost 20)**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.**
  - **DETOUR – Traffic will be detoured through Florida's Turnpike southbound to Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street/Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue.**
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184<sup>th</sup> Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104<sup>th</sup> Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. If necessary two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.

- **Southwest 168<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 21 through Friday, May 26.
- **Southwest 152<sup>nd</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 21 through Friday, May 26.
- **Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 21 through Friday, May 26.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 21 through Friday, May 26.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion in early 2017. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

#### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE**

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

#### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD (Exit 23)**

- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street – All eastbound and westbound lanes of Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed around-the-clock beginning at 10:30 p.m. Friday, May 19 and ending at 6 a.m., on Monday, May 21.**
  - Westbound DETOUR – Travel south on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue, then travel west on Sunset Drive and north on Southwest 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue to return to Miller Drive.
  - Eastbound DETOUR – Travel south on Southwest 127<sup>th</sup> Avenue, then travel east on Sunset Drive and north on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to return to Miller Drive.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72<sup>nd</sup> Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

- **Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 122<sup>nd</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25;  
**AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26.
- **Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26.
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56<sup>th</sup> Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Southwest 118<sup>th</sup> Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through early 2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

#### **TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES BIRD ROAD (Exit 23) to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 (Exit 26)**

- **The northbound entrance ramp from Southwest 8<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22 through Wednesday, May 24.**
  - **DETOUR– Travel north on SW 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue and then travel west on NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street to enter northbound Turnpike.**
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40<sup>th</sup> Street**, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express Lanes will also be constructed. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24<sup>th</sup> Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street and at the SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

#### **NW 199<sup>th</sup> STREET BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT**

- **Northbound entry ramp from NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street, continuous single lane closure**, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.
- **Northbound exit ramp to NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street, continuous single lane closure**, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at NW 199<sup>th</sup> Street**, Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. The first lane closes at 10 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 11:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** This project entails bridge painting and rehabilitation to the entrance and exit ramp to Northwest 199 Street in Miami Gardens. Work will begin in February 2017 and will continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$2.6 million.

#### **Sawgrass Expressway**

- **Pat Salerno Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22.
- **Lyons Road Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 23.

### **75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION**

#### **Florida's Turnpike**

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. ## TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

### Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard

- **Northbound and southbound, double lane closures**, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

### Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Northwest 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.
- **Eastbound and westbound**, double lane closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 23 through Thursday, May 25. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction on Sunrise Boulevard. Between the hours of 1 a.m. and 4 a.m. traffic may be stopped for periods of ten minutes or more while mast arms are being installed.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

## HILLSBORO BOULEVARD OVER FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound at Hillsboro Boulevard**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at Hillsboro Boulevard**, double lane closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26.
- **Hillsboro westbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26. ; **AND** 6 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26. A second lane may close beginning at 9 p.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements include replacing the pedestrian fencing on both the north and south side of the Hillsboro Bridge over Florida's Turnpike. It is estimated the project will be completed in summer 2017.

## SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY CANAL REVETMENT PROJECT

- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound exit ramp to University Drive**, one lane closed through July 2017. The ramp will remain open to traffic.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is continuing a construction project to repair and stabilize canal embankment slopes in the City of Parkland on the north side of the Sawgrass Expressway between Coral Springs Drive and University Drive; and between University Drive and Riverside Drive. It is estimated that the second and third phases of the project will cost about \$8 million and be complete in July 2017.

## **PALM BEACH COUNTY**

### **GLADES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS**

- **The northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed from 9 p.m. Sunday, May 21 to 5 a.m., Monday, May 22.**
  - **DETOUR– Exit Sample Road, travel north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.**
- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26; **AND** 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 21 through Thursday, May 25. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Glades Road and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from the northbound Turnpike to Glades Road to two lanes, adding an additional right turn lane from the Turnpike exit ramp to westbound Glades Road, and adding an auxiliary lane on the northbound Turnpike. Work also includes painting the existing Turnpike bridge over Glades Road and improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$8.3 million and construction is expected to be completed in summer 2018.

## **ST. LUCIE COUNTY**

### **PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION**

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike** is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is open, along with a new fuel station. Truck parking is also now available at the north end of the plaza.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.
