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SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, October 15. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Campbell Drive westbound approaching the Turnpike**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, October 16 through Thursday, October 19
- **Campbell Drive eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, double lane closure, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, October 16 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Campbell Drive eastbound between SW 15700 Block and NE 30th Terrace**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months in order to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152nd Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30th Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
SOUTHWEST 288th STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE (Exit 5) to SOUTHWEST 216th STREET**

- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound between Southwest 137th Avenue and Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288th Street and Southwest 112th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Southwest 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, October 16 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Southwest 112th Avenue/Tallahassee Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida’s Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Southbound exit ramp to Southwest 288th Street/Biscayne Drive, full closure, 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, October 16 and Thursday, October 19.**
 - DETOUR – Exit at Southwest 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road and travel south to Southwest 288th Street.
- **Northbound entrance ramps from Southwest 288th Street/Biscayne Drive, full closure, 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, October 16 and Thursday, October 19.**
 - DETOUR – Travel north on Southwest 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road to enter northbound Florida’s Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137th Avenue and SW 112th Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
EUREKA DRIVE (Exit 13) to KILLIAN PARKWAY (Milepost 20)**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured through Florida’s Turnpike southbound to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue.
- **Florida’s Turnpike – All lanes southbound on Florida’s Turnpike between Southwest 120th Street and Southwest 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, October 18 to 5 a.m.**

Thursday, October 19. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place from 11 p.m. Thursday, October 19 to 5 a.m. Friday, October 20.

- DETOUR – Exit at Southwest 120th Street and travel south to Southwest 117th Avenue to Southwest 152nd Street/Coral Reef Drive to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- **The southbound Turnpike on ramp from Southwest 120th Street will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, October 18 to 5 a.m. Thursday, October 19. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place from 11 p.m. Thursday, October 19 to 5 a.m. Friday, October 20.**
 - DETOUR – Traffic will be detoured to continue east on Southwest 120th Street, then travel south on Southwest 117th Avenue, continue east on Southwest 152nd Street/ Coral Reef Drive enter southbound Turnpike.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104th Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.
- **Southwest 168th Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Southwest 152nd Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Southwest 120th Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD (Exit 23)**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72nd Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street**, Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 122nd Avenue**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. ; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.
- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 118th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through mid-2018. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
BIRD ROAD (Exit 23) to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 (Exit 26)**

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound at various locations between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street**, Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Tamiami Trail /Southwest 8th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 114th Avenue and Southwest 122nd Avenue**, multiple lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Flagler Street eastbound and westbound between Northwest 118th Avenue and Northwest 117th Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express Lanes will also be constructed. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24th Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8th Street and at the SW 8th Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

- **Pat Salerno Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Tuesday, October 17 to 5 a.m., Wednesday, October 18.
- **University Drive Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, October 19 to 5 a.m., Friday, October 20.
- **Lyons Road Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Wednesday, October 18 to 5 a.m., Thursday, October 19.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

Florida's Turnpike

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard

- **Northbound and southbound**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47th Avenue and Northwest 56th Avenue

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, October 16 through Friday, October 20. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

PALM BEACH COUNTY

GLADES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound, approaching Glades Road**, Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. The first lane closes at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Glades Road westbound approaching the Turnpike**, nightly single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19. A second lane may close beginning at 10 p.m.
- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, daily single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound approaching Glades Road**, two lanes will be closed on Saturday, October 14 through Sunday, October 15. The first lane will close at 9 p.m. and the second lane will close beginning at 11 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 9 a.m. Sunday, October 15.
- **The northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed from midnight to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 15.**
 - **DETOUR– Motorists will be directed to exit at Sample Road, travel north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Glades Road and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from the northbound Turnpike to Glades Road to two lanes, adding an additional right turn lane from the Turnpike exit ramp to westbound Glades Road, and adding an auxiliary lane on the northbound Turnpike. Work also includes painting the existing Turnpike bridge over Glades Road and improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$8.3 million and construction is expected to be completed in summer 2018.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD TO SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closure**, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closure, 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, October 15 through Thursday, October 19.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida's Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107). This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. The following ramps will be resurfaced: Southern Boulevard, Jog Road and Okeechobee Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$16.8 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2018.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida's Turnpike** is under reconstruction. A new convenience store with limited food service is open, along with a new fuel station. Truck parking is also now available at the north end of the plaza.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.
