SOUTH FLORIDA AND TREASURE COAST WEEKLY LANE CLOSURES AND WORK ZONE ADVISORY

FORT LAUDERDALE — [Florida's Turnpike](#) announces updated lane closures and work zones due to construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie counties, for the week beginning Sunday, March 18. All paving-related lane closures depend on weather conditions; rain may delay or cancel paving operations.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

TURNPIKE MAINTENANCE

Florida's Turnpike

- **Okeechobee Toll Plaza southbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9 p.m. Monday, March 19 to 5 a.m., Tuesday, March 20.
- **Okeechobee Toll Plaza northbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, March 19 to 5 a.m., Tuesday, March 20.
- **NW 57th Toll Plaza southbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Wednesday, March 21 to 5 a.m., Thursday, March 22.
- **NW 57th Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 9 p.m. Thursday, March 22 to 5 a.m., Friday, March 23.
- **NW 27th Toll Plaza southbound entry ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, March 22 to 5 a.m., Friday, March 23.
- **NW 27th Toll Plaza northbound exit ramp**, partial lane closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, March 22 to 5 a.m., Friday, March 23.

**CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE
MODIFICATION PROJECT**

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike at various locations between Campbell Drive and south of Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Campbell Drive westbound approaching Florida's Turnpike**, double lane closure, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Thursday, March 22; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Campbell Drive eastbound approaching Florida's Turnpike**, double lane closure, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.; **AND** 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Campbell Drive eastbound between SW 15700 Block and NE 30th Terrace**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.
- **Campbell Drive westbound between NE 30th Terrace and SW 15700 Block**, continuous single lane closure. This new traffic pattern will be in effect for approximately four months to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel east on Campbell Drive, continue north on SW 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road and then travel west on SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive to enter northbound Turnpike. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel north on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway to Campbell Drive. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to travel west on Campbell Drive and continue south on US 1/ S. Dixie Highway. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.
- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive may be closed nightly from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive (Exit 5), continue east on SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and travel south on SW 137th Avenue /Tallahassee Road to Campbell Drive. *Please note, entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Campbell Drive and Florida's Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from southbound Turnpike to Campbell Drive to two lanes, constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and SW 152nd Avenue and widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30th Terrace. Work also includes intersection improvements as well as adding new signals, lighting and drainage. Construction began in 2017 and is expected to continue through summer 2018. Approximate cost is \$15 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
SOUTHWEST 288th STREET/BISCAYNE DRIVE (Exit 5) to SOUTHWEST 216th STREET**

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound between Southwest 216th Avenue and Southwest 288th Street**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Southwest 288th Street and Southwest 216th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Southwest 288th Street/Biscayne Drive eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Southwest 137th Avenue/Tallahassee Road northbound and southbound in the vicinity of the Florida's Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **SW 137th Avenue/ Tallahassee Road in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass, northbound and southbound closure, 9 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**
 - NORTHBOUND DETOUR – Travel west on SW 288th Avenue/Biscayne Drive, then continue north to US 1, continue east on SW 280th Street to return to SW 137th Avenue/ Tallahassee Road.
 - SOUTHBOUND DETOUR – Travel west on SW 272nd Street, then continue south to US 1, continue east on SW 288th Street to return to SW 137th Avenue/ Tallahassee Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road. Nearly six miles of sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike. Work also includes realigning travel lanes, widening bridges at SW 137th Avenue and SW 112th Avenue, reconstructing the Homestead Toll Gantry, plus asphalt milling and resurfacing, drainage improvements and signage and lighting improvements. Construction began in 2016 and is expected to continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost is \$70 million.

**TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES
EUREKA DRIVE (Exit 13) to KILLIAN PARKWAY (Milepost 20)**

- **SR 874/Don Shula Expressway exit ramp to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue, full closure, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 23.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be directed through Florida's Turnpike southbound to Southwest 152nd Street/Southwest 117th Avenue.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound or southbound between Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive and Southwest 104th Street/Killian Parkway**, single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. If necessary, two lanes in each direction may be closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. One or more lanes will be open at all times.

- **Southwest 168th Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Southwest 152nd Street**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Southwest 120th Avenue**, single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound frontage road**, single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened to eight and 12 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. The Turnpike/S.R. 874 interchange will be realigned. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, landscaping, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in March 2014 and is scheduled for completion spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$145.3 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES KILLIAN PARKWAY to SUNSET DRIVE

- **Northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike between Killian Parkway and north of Sunset Drive**, single and double lane closures, Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Sunset Drive/ Southwest 72nd Street eastbound and westbound in the vicinity of the Turnpike overpass**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22 **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The Turnpike on-ramps at Kendall Drive will be reconfigured. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements on local roads. Construction began in May 2015 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$73.9 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES SUNSET DRIVE to BIRD ROAD (Exit 23)

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound at various locations between Sunset Drive/Southwest 72nd Street and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street**, Thursday, March 22. The first lane closes at 9:30 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10:30 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.
- **Southwest 117th Avenue northbound and southbound between Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street and Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street**, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, March 22; **AND** 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, March 23.

- **Miller Drive/Southwest 56th Street eastbound and westbound between Southwest 117th Avenue and Southwest 118th Avenue, single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Thursday, March 22 through Friday, March 23 AND 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, March 23.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express lanes will also be constructed. Sound barrier walls will be built along residential areas. The project entails major improvements at the Bird Road interchange. Work also includes asphalt milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements. Construction began in July 2015 and will continue through fall 2019. Approximate cost: \$54.4 million.

TURNPIKE WIDENING, SOUND WALLS AND EXPRESS LANES BIRD ROAD (Exit 23) to DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY/SR 836 (Exit 26)

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound between Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 and Bird Road/Southwest 40th Street, double lane closures, 1 a.m. to 5 a.m., Friday, March 22.**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Turnpike will be widened from six to 10 lanes. Express Lanes will also be constructed. The project entails major modifications at the Dolphin Expressway/SR 836 interchange. Work includes replacing the Coral Way/SW 24th Street bridge over SR 821; operational, safety and capacity improvements for motorists and pedestrians on SW 8th Street and at the SW 8th Street interchange; and minor road improvements on West Flagler Street. Additionally, sound barrier walls along residential areas, road milling and resurfacing, drainage, lighting, signage and traffic signal improvements are planned. Construction will begin in summer 2016 and will continue through spring 2019. Approximate cost: \$112 million.

BROWARD COUNTY

TURNPIKE MAINTENANCE

Sawgrass Expressway

- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound exit ramp to Sample Road will be closed from 10 p.m. Wednesday, March 21 to 5 a.m. Thursday, March 22.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to exit southbound Sawgrass Expressway at Coral Ridge Drive (Exit 14), travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Sample Road.
- **Sawgrass Expressway southbound entry ramp from Lyons Road will be closed from 10 p.m. Thursday, March 22 to 5 a.m. Friday, March 23.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to travel south on Lyons Road, continue westbound on Wiles Road and travel northbound on SR 7/US 441 to enter southbound Sawgrass Expressway.

Florida's Turnpike

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from Griffin Road will be closed from 10 p.m. Tuesday, March 20 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, March 21.**
 - DETOUR – Motorists will be detoured to travel north on SR 7/US 441 to enter northbound Turnpike.

75-EXPRESS CONSTRUCTION

Florida's Turnpike

- **Northbound ramp from Okeechobee Road to I-75 Interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Okeechobee Road to I-75 interchange northbound and southbound**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Northbound and southbound between Red Road and the I-75 interchange**, single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida Department of Transportation is implementing express lanes along 28 miles of the I-75 and State Road (SR) 826 (Palmetto Expressway) corridors, from just south of the SR 836 (Dolphin Expressway), in Miami-Dade County, to I-595 in Broward County. TURNPIKE & SUNRISE BOULEVARD (Exit 58) INTERCHANGE MODIFICATIONS

Florida's Turnpike between Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) and Broward Boulevard

- **Northbound and southbound**, double lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. A third lane in each direction may close beginning at 11 p.m. All lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.

Sunrise Boulevard between Northwest 47th Avenue and Northwest 56th Avenue

- **Eastbound and westbound**, single lane closure, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.; **AND** 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. A second lane in each direction may close beginning at 10 p.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike is modifying and improving the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard, and implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the interchange. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$50 million and work will continue through late 2019.

PALM BEACH COUNTY

GLADES ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound, approaching Glades Road**, Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. The first lane closes at 9 p.m., and the second lane will close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 6 a.m.
- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to Glades Road will be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.**

- **DETOUR** – Motorists will be directed to exit northbound Turnpike at Sample Road (Exit 69), travel east on Sample Road and north on Powerline Road to Glades Road.
- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, nightly single lane closure, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. A second lane may close beginning at 10 p.m.
- **Glades Road westbound and eastbound approaching the Turnpike**, daily single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sunday, March 18 through Friday, March 23.
- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound and southbound exit and entrance ramp from Glades road**, single lane closure, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22; **AND** multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22. A second lane may close beginning at 10 p.m. Both lanes will reopen by 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Improvements to be constructed at the interchange of Glades Road and Florida’s Turnpike include widening the exit ramp from the northbound Turnpike to Glades Road to two lanes, adding an additional right turn lane from the Turnpike exit ramp to westbound Glades Road, and adding an auxiliary lane on the northbound Turnpike. Work also includes painting the existing Turnpike bridge over Glades Road and improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$8.3 million and construction is expected to be completed in summer 2018.

FLORIDA’S TURNPIKE RESURFACING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD TO SOUTH OF BEELINE HIGHWAY

- **Florida’s Turnpike northbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closure**, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, March 18 through Thursday, March 22.
- **Florida’s Turnpike southbound at various locations between north of Lake Worth Road and south of Beeline Highway, single lane closure**, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday, March 18 **AND** 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, March 19 through Thursday, March 22.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Asphalt milling and resurfacing on Florida’s Turnpike from north of Lake Worth Road (Exit 93) to south of Beeline Highway (Exit 107). This project also includes improvements to signing and pavement markings. The following ramps will be resurfaced: Southern Boulevard, Jog Road and Okeechobee Boulevard. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$16.8 million and construction is expected to be completed in late 2018.

ST. LUCIE COUNTY

PORT ST. LUCIE/FORT PIERCE SERVICE PLAZA (Milepost 144) RECONSTRUCTION

- **The Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza on Florida’s Turnpike** is under reconstruction. All plaza services are being maintained during this time. Motorist should expect changes in traffic patterns and parking and follow all plaza signing. Truck and RV parking is located at the north end of the plaza.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The \$21 million project to renovate and reconstruct the Port St. Lucie/Fort Pierce Service Plaza includes a 40,000-square-foot restaurant building; 3,500-square-foot convenience store and fueling pumps; and expanded truck parking.
