Continuous Closures of All Northbound and Southbound Lanes of SW 117th Avenue underneath the Coral Way Bridge overpass at Florida's Turnpike

Miami, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike has scheduled a continuous complete closure of all northbound and southbound lanes on SW 117th Avenue underneath the Coral Way Bridge overpass at Florida's Turnpike. These temporary closures will allow crews to safely demolish the existing bridge portion and continue bridge construction activities in this area. To complete this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Northbound and southbound SW 117th Avenue underneath the Coral Way Bridge overpass at Florida's Turnpike

Full closure, 6 a.m. Saturday, June 1 to 10 p.m. Sunday, June 2.

Detour information:

- Northbound SW 117th Avenue traffic will be directed to travel east on SW 32nd Street, travel north on SW 107th Avenue and travel west on Coral Way/SW 24th Street to access SW 117th Avenue.
- Southbound SW 117th Avenue traffic will be directed to travel east on Coral Way/SW 24th Street, travel south on SW 107th Avenue and travel west on SW 32nd Street to access SW 117th Avenue.

Motorists traveling eastbound and westbound on the Coral Way bridge over Florida's Turnpike will not be affected by these closures.

This work is part of the ongoing widening of Florida's Turnpike between Bird Road/SW 40th Street and Dolphin Expressway/MDX SR 836. Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
