Continuous Weekend Closure of Florida's Turnpike Entrance and Exit Ramps at Sunrise Boulevard

Traffic will be detoured from 11:45 p.m. Friday, November 30 to 5 a.m. Monday, December 3

FORT LAUDERDALE — Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled continuous weekend closures of Florida's Turnpike entrance and exit ramps at Sunrise Boulevard to allow crews to demolish the existing toll plaza. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- Florida's Turnpike northbound entrance ramp from eastbound and westbound Sunrise Boulevard will be closed continuously from 11:45 p.m. Friday, November 30 to 5 a.m., Monday, December 3.

 Motorists traveling eastbound on Sunrise Boulevard wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike. Motorists traveling westbound on Sunrise Boulevard wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441/SR 7 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to westbound Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58B) will be closed continuously from 11:45 p.m. Friday, November 30 to 5 a.m., Monday, December 3.

 Motorists traveling northbound on Florida's Turnpike wishing to access westbound Sunrise Boulevard will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard (Exit 62), continue east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7 and continue south on US 441/SR 7 to access Sunrise Boulevard. *Please note, Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to eastbound Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58A) will remain open.
- Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from westbound Sunrise Boulevard will be closed continuously from 11:45 p.m. Friday, November 30 to 5 a.m., Monday, December 3.

 Motorists traveling westbound on Sunrise Boulevard wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue to US 441/SR 7 and travel south on US 441/SR 7 to westbound I-595 to access southbound Florida's Turnpike. *Please note, Florida's Turnpike southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Sunrise Boulevard will remain open.
- Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to eastbound and westbound Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) will be closed continuously from 11:45 p.m. Friday, November 30 to 5 a.m., Monday, December 3.
 Motorists traveling southbound on Florida's Turnpike wishing to access Sunrise Boulevard will be directed to exit at I-595 (Exit 54), travel east on I-595 to US 441/SR 7 and travel north on US 441/SR 7 to access Sunrise Boulevard.

Motorists traveling on northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike as well as on eastbound and westbound Sunrise Boulevard over Florida's Turnpike will not be affected by these closures. This schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
