Eastbound and Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 To Close between Jetport Drive/Orange Avenue and Conway Road/Tradeport Drive *Nighttime Closures from 12:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m., Thursday, June 6 and Friday, June 7*

Ocoee, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike has scheduled a full closure of the eastbound and westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 travel lanes between Jetport Drive/Orange Avenue (Exit 8) and Tradeport Drive (Exit 9) to allow crews to raise an overhead sign structure. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 at Jetport Drive/Orange Avenue (Exit 8)

Full road closure, 12:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m., Thursday June 6 and Friday, June 7.

Detour information:

- Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to continue east on Beachline Expressway will be directed to exit at Jetport Drive (Exit 8), travel east on Jetport Drive to access the ramp to eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528.

Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 at Tradeport Drive/Conway Road (Exit 9)

Full road closure, 12:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m., Thursday, June 6 and Friday, June 7.

Detour information:

- Westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 traffic wishing to continue west on Beachline Expressway/SR 528 will be directed to exit at Tradeport Drive/Conway Road (Exit 9), travel south on Tradeport Drive to McCoy Road, then travel west on McCoy Road to access westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528.

This work is part of the ongoing widening and improvement project on Beachline Expressway/SR 528 between Florida's Turnpike and McCoy Road / Jetport Drive / Orange Avenue. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
