Extended Single Lane Closure of Northbound Florida's Turnpike between I-4 and the Turkey Lake Service Plaza *Single-lane closure will reopen in the Winter of 2020*

Ocoee, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike is scheduled to temporarily close one northbound lane between I-4 (Exit 259) and the Turkey Lake Service Plaza through the end of the year. This extended single-lane closure will allow crews to construct and widen this area for future expansion of northbound Florida's Turnpike. Three lanes will remain open.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike between north of I-4 (Exit 259) and south of the Turkey Lake Service Plaza (MP 259.5)

Extended single-lane closure beginning at 10 p.m., Sunday, August 11, through the end of the year.

The work is part of the Florida's Turnpike widening project from the Beachline Expressway to I-4 and the construction of flyover ramps to directly connect Florida's Turnpike to and from I-4.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
