FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for the Design of Suncoast Parkway 2 Phase 2

Ocoee, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will hold a Public Information Meeting for the design of Suncoast Parkway 2 State Road (SR) 589, Phase 2, a new limited access, tolled roadway from SR 44 to County Road (CR) 486, in Citrus County, Florida (Financial Project Identification Number: 442764-1).

The Public Information Meeting will be held Thursday, January 23 at the Citrus County National Guard Armory, located at 8551 W. Venable Street, Crystal River, FL 34429. The meeting will be an informal open house from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. There will be no formal presentation. In the event the Public Information Meeting cannot be held on January 23 due to severe weather or unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate date of February 18 at the same time and place. This Public Information Meeting will give interested persons an opportunity to ask the project team questions and provide comments. Displays illustrating the alternatives for the proposed design will be available for review.
