## **CLOSING - All Southbound Turnpike lanes at SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street**

**To be closed overnight from 11 p.m. Wednesday, November 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, November 9**

FORT LAUDERDALE —The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled full closures on southbound Florida's Turnpike to allow crews to pour concrete for bridge construction. In order to perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **All southbound lanes on Florida's Turnpike at SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street** will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, November 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, November 9. Motorists will be directed to exit at SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 19), travel east along SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street, travel south on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Coral Reef Drive/SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street, and travel east on Coral Reef Drive/SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike. If necessary to complete the work, these lane closures will also take place nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, November 13 and Tuesday, November 14.
- **The southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp from SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street** will be closed from 11 p.m. Wednesday, November 8 to 5 a.m. Thursday, November 9. Motorists will be directed to continue east on SW 120<sup>th</sup> Street, travel south on Southwest 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Coral Reef Drive/SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street, and travel east on Coral Reef Drive/SW 152<sup>nd</sup> Street to re-enter southbound Florida's Turnpike. If necessary to complete the work, this ramp closure will also take place nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, November 13 and Tuesday, November 14.

This work is part of the ongoing \$145.3 million widening project on Florida's Turnpike between Eureka Drive/SW 184<sup>th</sup> Street to Killian Parkway/SW 104<sup>th</sup> Street. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unexpected conditions.
