**New Southbound Florida's Turnpike and Southbound I-75
Entrance Ramps from SR 44 Now Open**

Ocoee, Fla. – As of Friday, November 1, motorists traveling on SR 44 wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike or southbound I-75 will use new entrance ramps in Sumter County.

Overhead signs and portable message boards have been installed along the corridor to reflect the new traffic pattern. Motorists are encouraged to use caution and follow the posted signage.

This work is part of the current Florida's Turnpike and I-75 interchange improvements project.
