Nightly Closures of Florida's Turnpike Northbound and Southbound Exit Ramps to PGA Boulevard

PALM BEACH COUNTY — Florida's Turnpike has scheduled nightly closures of Florida's Turnpike northbound and southbound PGA Boulevard exit ramps to allow crews to perform paving, lighting and construction activities. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- **Florida's Turnpike northbound exit ramp to eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard will be closed for the following periods:**
 - 10 p.m. Friday, February 1 to 9 a.m. Saturday, February 2.
 - 10 p.m. Saturday, February 2 to 9 a.m. Sunday, February 3.

Motorists traveling northbound on Florida's Turnpike wishing to access PGA Boulevard will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway (Exit 107) to Jog Road, travel south on Jog Road to Beeline Highway, continue east on Beeline Highway to Military Trail and continue north on Military Trail to access PGA Boulevard.

- **Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard will be closed for the following periods:**
 - 8 p.m. Tuesday, February 5 to 6 a.m. Wednesday, February 6.
 - 8 p.m. Wednesday, February 6 to 6 a.m. Thursday, February 7

Motorists traveling southbound on Florida's Turnpike wishing to access PGA Boulevard will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway (Exit 107) to Jog Road, travel south on Jog Road to Beeline Highway, continue east on Beeline Highway to Military Trail and continue north on Military Trail to access PGA Boulevard.

- One lane of northbound Florida's Turnpike at PGA Boulevard will be closed from 10 p.m. Friday, February 1 to 6 a.m. Saturday, February 2 and then from 10 p.m. Saturday, February 2 to 6 a.m. Sunday, February 3.

Motorists traveling on eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard over Florida's Turnpike will not be affected by these closures. This schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
