Northbound and Southbound Florida's Turnpike To Close between SW 112th Avenue and SW 216th Street

Nighttime Closures from 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, May 6 through Wednesday, May 8

Miami, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike has scheduled a full closure of the northbound and southbound travel lanes between SW 112th Avenue and SW 216th Street to allow crews to shift traffic to a new pattern just north and south of the toll gantry in this area and to raise an overhead sign structure. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Northbound Florida's Turnpike from SW 112th Avenue to SW 216th Street

Full road closure, 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Tuesday, May 7 and Wednesday, May 8.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue north on Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at SW 112th Avenue (Exit 9), travel north on SW 112th Avenue to SW 216th Street, travel east on SW 216th Street to the frontage road and travel north on the frontage road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike from SW 216th Street and SW 112th Avenue

Full road closure, 11 p.m. to 4:30 a.m., Monday, May 6 or Tuesday, May 7.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue south on Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at SW 216th Street (Exit 11), travel west on SW 216th Street to SW 112th Avenue and travel south on SW 112th Avenue to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
