## **Overnight Closure of Southbound Turnpike Exit Ramp to Eastbound Southwest 8<sup>th</sup> Street** Traffic will be detoured nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, June 24 through Thursday, June 28

MIAMI —The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has scheduled the overnight closure of the Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to eastbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street (Exit 25) to allow crews to perform construction activities in this area. In order to complete this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

- Florida's Turnpike southbound exit ramp to eastbound SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, June 24 through Thursday, June 28. Motorists will be directed to exit southbound Turnpike at Bird Road (Exit 23), travel east on Bird Road and travel north on SW 117<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street.

If necessary to complete this work, these closures will also occur nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, July 8 through Thursday, July 12.

This work is part of the Turnpike's ongoing widening project on Florida's Turnpike between Bird Road/SW 40<sup>th</sup> Street to Dolphin Expressway/SR 836. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
