Rescheduled: Northbound and Southbound Florida's Turnpike between Osceola Parkway and the Orlando South Interchange to Close

Ocoee, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike has rescheduled a full closure of the northbound and southbound travel lanes between Osceola Parkway and the Orlando South interchange to allow crews to perform bridge work. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Northbound Florida's Turnpike at Osceola Parkway (Exit 249)

Full closure, 11 p.m. Sunday, March 10 to 5 a.m. Monday March 11. Similar closures will also occur on Tuesday, March 12 and Thursday, March 14.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at Osceola Parkway (Exit 249), travel west on Osceola Parkway to US 441/Orange Blossom Trail and travel north on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue north to northbound Central Florida GreeneWay (SR 417) will be directed to exit at Osceola Parkway (Exit 249), travel east on Osceola Parkway to Landstar Boulevard and travel north on Landstar Boulevard to access northbound Central Florida GreeneWay (SR 417).
- Eastbound and westbound Osceola Parkway traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel north on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike at Exit 254 (Orlando South Interchange)

Full closure, 11 p.m. Sunday, March 10 to 6 a.m. Monday, March 11.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at southbound US 441/Orange Blossom Trail (Exit 254), travel south on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound US 441/Orange Blossom Trail traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel north on Consulate Drive to Delegates Drive, travel south on Delegates Drive to Principal Row, travel east on Principal Row to US 441/Orange Blossom Trail, travel south on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

- Eastbound Beachline Expressway (SR 528) traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at Consulate Drive (Exit 4), travel south on Consulate Drive to US 441/Orange Blossom Trail, travel south on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Westbound Beachline Expressway (SR 528) traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at Landstreet Road (Exit 4), travel east on Landstreet Road to US 441/Orange Blossom Trail, travel south on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to Consulate Drive and make a U-Turn and travel north on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Westbound Beachline Expressway (SR 528) traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at Landstreet Road (Exit 4), travel east on Landstreet Road to US 441/Orange Blossom Trail, travel south on US 441/Orange Blossom Trail to Osceola Parkway and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

This work is part of the ongoing widening and improvements project on Florida's Turnpike between Osceola Parkway and the Beachline Expressway/SR 528. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
