Weekend Closures of Florida's Turnpike Northbound Exit Ramp to PGA Boulevard/SR 786

Palm Beach County, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike has scheduled weekend closures of the northbound exit ramp to PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109) to allow crews to perform paving and construction activities including safety guardrail improvements. To perform this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to PGA Boulevard/SR 786 (Exit 109)

Full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Saturday, April 6 to 9 a.m. Sunday, April 7.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access PGA Boulevard/SR 786 will be directed to exit at Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107), travel south on Jog Road to Beeline Highway/SR 710, travel east on Beeline Highway/SR 710 to Military Trail/SR 809 and travel north on Military Trail/SR 809 to access PGA Boulevard/SR 786.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike at PGA Boulevard/SR 786

Single lane closures, 10 p.m. Saturday, April 6 to 6 a.m. Sunday, April 7.

Motorists traveling on eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard/SR 786 over Florida's Turnpike will not be affected by these closures. Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
