



All-Electronic Tolling Begins Soon

Several locations along Florida's Turnpike are converting to All-Electronic Tolling (AET) beginning at Noon on Thursday, March 19.

– Cash Will No Longer Be Accepted –

On Thursday, March 19, 2020, starting at noon, Florida's Turnpike will be implementing All-Electronic Tolling at the following locations:

- Glades Road (Exit 75)
- Atlantic Avenue (Exit 81)
- Boynton Beach Boulevard (Exit 86)

This means that **cash will no longer be accepted** at these locations and tolls will be collected electronically using a SunPass, other interoperable transponder, or TOLL-BY-PLATE.

SunPass Advantages

- **Pay lower toll rates.** SunPass customers pay the lowest toll rates available on Florida roads and most bridges.
- **SunPass works outside of Florida.** SunPass can be used on toll roads and express lanes in North Carolina and Georgia, with more states coming soon.
- **Use your SunPass to pay for parking.** SunPass customers enrolled in Easy Pay can pay for parking at designated SunPass Plus facilities such as Hard Rock Stadium in Miami, as well as Tampa International, Orlando International, Miami International, Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International and Palm Beach International Airports.
- **Avoid additional fees.** TOLL-BY-PLATE customers pay a higher toll rate plus a monthly \$2.50 administrative fee by invoice.
- **Purchasing is easy.** Visit one of the 3,100 retail locations in Florida, including Publix Super Markets, CVS Pharmacy, Walgreens, Navarro Discount Pharmacies, Sedano's Supermarkets, Amscot, all AAA locations in Florida, Florida Welcome Centers, and all Florida's Turnpike Service Plaza gift shops and Shell convenience stores.
