



Construction Alert

All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Project 5A

On the morning of Wednesday, February 12, all travel lanes on northbound Florida's Turnpike, just north of Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 62) will shift to the right (east side) of the roadway as part of the next phase of this construction project.

In order to implement this lane shift, the following lane closure will be scheduled:

Northbound Florida's Turnpike at Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 62)

Overnight full road closure, 11:30 p.m. Tuesday, February 11, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, February 12. If necessary to complete the work, this closure may also occur from 11:30 p.m. Wednesday, February 12, to 5 a.m. Thursday, February 13.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/ SR 870 (Exit 62), travel east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to Coconut Creek Parkway and travel east on Coconut Creek Parkway to northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access the Pompano Beach Service Plaza will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/ SR 870 (Exit 62), travel east on Commercial Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to Coconut Creek Parkway and travel east on Coconut Creek Parkway to southbound Florida's Turnpike, where they will be able to access the Pompano Beach Service Plaza.
- Eastbound and westbound Commercial Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to US 441/SR 7, travel north on US 441 to Coconut Creek Parkway and travel east on Coconut Creek Parkway to northbound Florida's Turnpike.

This schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
