



Construction Alert



All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Project 5A

On the morning of Tuesday, March 3, all travel lanes on southbound Florida's Turnpike, just north of Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 62) will shift to the right (west side) of the roadway as part of the next phase of this construction project.

In order to implement this lane shift, the following road closure will be scheduled:

Southbound Florida's Turnpike at Coconut Creek Parkway (Exit 67)

Overnight full road closure, 11 p.m. Monday, March 2, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 3.

If necessary to complete the work, this closure may also occur from 11 p.m. Thursday, March 5, to 5 a.m. Friday, March 6; and 11 p.m. Monday, March 9, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, March 10.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Coconut Creek Parkway/ML King Boulevard (Exit 67), travel west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access SB Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Eastbound and westbound Coconut Creek Parkway/ML King Boulevard traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike will be directed to continue west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access the Pompano Beach Service Plaza will be directed to exit at Coconut Creek Parkway/ML King Boulevard (Exit 67), travel west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access NB Florida's Turnpike, where they will be able to access the Pompano Beach Service Plaza.
- Pompano Beach Service Plaza traffic wishing to access SB Florida's Turnpike will be directed to travel north on Florida's Turnpike and exit at Coconut Creek Parkway/ML King Boulevard (Exit 67), travel west on Coconut Creek Parkway to US 441/SR 7, travel south on US 441 to Commercial Boulevard and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

This schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
