



CAMPBELL DRIVE AND TURNPIKE INTERCHANGE MODIFICATION PROJECT



PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- ◆ Improving traffic flow through modifications to the interchange at Florida's Turnpike and Campbell Drive (Exit 2)
- ◆ Constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from westbound Campbell Drive and northbound SW 152nd Avenue
- ◆ Widening the southbound exit ramp to Campbell Drive to two lanes
- ◆ Widening Campbell Drive to three lanes from SW 15700 Block to NE 30th Terrace
- ◆ Improvements to signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting and drainage
- ◆ Sound walls will be built along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike

CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours.

These lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. There may also be lane closures, reductions and detours on cross streets.

Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration and dust. Efforts will be made to limit disruptions for adjacent neighbors as much as possible.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work at the Florida's Turnpike and Campbell Drive (Exit 2) interchange is anticipated to begin in April 2017 and continue through summer 2018.

COST AND FUNDING

The project cost is approximately \$15 million. This project is funded by toll and concessions revenue, not taxes.
