



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

SW 117TH AVENUE NIGHTLY CLOSURES

Florida's Turnpike has scheduled nightly closures of all northbound and southbound lanes on SW 117th Avenue, underneath the Coral Way Bridge. These temporary closures will allow crews to continue bridge construction in this area. To complete this work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Southbound SW 117th Avenue underneath Coral Way/24th Street

Full road closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 17 through Wednesday, June 19.

Detour information:

- Southbound SW 117th Avenue traffic will be directed to travel east on Coral Way, travel south on SW 107th Avenue and travel west on SW 32nd Street to access SW 117th Avenue.

Northbound SW 117th Avenue underneath Coral Way/24th Street

Full road closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, June 19 through Friday, June 21 and Monday, June 24.

Detour information:

- Northbound SW 117th Avenue traffic will be directed to travel east on SW 32nd Street, travel north on SW 107th Avenue and travel west on Coral Way to access SW 117th Avenue.

Westbound Coral Way/24th Street over Florida's Turnpike

Full road closure, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 17 through Friday, June 21 and Monday, June 24.

Detour information:

- Coral Way traffic will be directed to SW 107th Avenue, travel south on 107th Avenue to Bird Road/SW 40th Street, travel west on Bird Road to SW 122nd Avenue and travel north on SW 122nd Avenue to access Coral Way.

This work is part of the ongoing widening of Florida's Turnpike between Bird Road/SW 40th Street and the Dolphin Expressway/MDX SR 836. Please note, this schedule may change due to inclement weather or other unforeseen conditions.
