

Florida's Turnpike Extension Widening Project From I-75 to Turnpike Mainline/SR 91

Project Description

- Widening Turnpike from four to eight lanes, between Interstate 75 and the Turnpike mainline
- Constructing sound walls along qualifying residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike
- Intersection improvements at Red Road/NW 57 Avenue and University Drive/NW 27 Avenue
- Widening of Turnpike bridges over Flamingo Road/NW 67 Avenue, Red Road, Palm Avenue/ NW 47 Avenue, Douglas Road/NW 37 Avenue, University Drive and Snake Creek Canal
- Asphalt milling and resurfacing, new lane striping, drainage, landscaping, traffic signal improvements on local roads and signage and lighting improvements
- Improving signage, pavement markings and lighting

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in Florida's Turnpike South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to be completed in 2022.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$143 million.

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
