



TURNPIKE WIDENING PROJECT SW 288TH STREET TO SW 216TH STREET

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- ◆ Widening Turnpike from four to six lanes, including express lanes, between SW 288th Street/Biscayne Drive and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road
- ◆ Construct sound walls along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike
- ◆ Realignment of travel lanes between SW 112th Avenue/Allapattah Road and SW 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Road
- ◆ Widening and barrier upgrade of bridges at SW 137th Avenue and SW 112th Avenue
- ◆ Reconstruction of Homestead Toll Gantry north of current location and demolition of former toll administration building
- ◆ Asphalt milling and resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping and traffic delineators (“plastic poles”), drainage improvements, signage and lighting improvements.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is anticipated to be completed in Spring 2019.

COST AND FUNDING

The project cost is approximately \$70 million. This project is funded by toll and concessions revenue, not taxes.



CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will take place during both daytime and night time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in the Florida’s Turnpike weekly traffic advisory.
