

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE

TURNPIKE WIDENINGPROJECT SOUTH OF KILLIAN PARKWAY TO NORTH OF SUNSET DRIVE

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Widening Turnpike from six to ten lanes, including express lanes, between Killian Parkway/SW 104th Street and Sunset Drive/SW 72nd Street
- Construct sound walls along residential areas adjacent to the Turnpike from north of Killian Parkway to South of Kendall Drive, and from north of Kendall Drive to south of Sunset Drive
- Widening of Turnpike bridges over Sunset Drive and Kendall Drive
- Construction of new express-lane toll gantries south of Kendall Drive and construction of new toll gantries on the northbound exit ramp and southbound entrance ramps at Kendall Drive
- Asphalt milling and resurfacing, new lane striping and traffic delineators ("plastic poles"), additional drainage, landscaping, traffic signal improvements on local roads and signage and lighting improvements.

CONSTRUCTION AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction will take place during both daytime and night time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in the Florida's Turnpike weekly traffic advisory.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Work is anticipated to be completed in spring 2019.

COST AND FUNDING

The project cost is approximately \$73.9 million. This project is funded by toll and concessions revenue, not taxes.
