



Polk Parkway Resurfacing and Roadside Improvement Project From Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (Mileposts 0 to 8)

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) has begun a resurfacing and roadside improvement project along Polk Parkway/SR 570.

This project consists of resurfacing an eight-mile segment of the Polk Parkway from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza. Improvements include:

- Bridge joint replacements
- Guardrail installation
- Signal and lighting improvements at S. Frontage Road and Harden Boulevard
- Signing, drainage and pavement marking improvements

Construction and Traffic Impacts

FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts. Travel lane closures and detours will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers.

Closures will be announced in advance in Florida's Turnpike Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration and dust.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work will begin this winter and is anticipated to be completed in Spring 2021.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$13.5 million.
