



## Sunrise Boulevard and Turnpike Interchange Modification Project

– **Project Has Begun** –

### Project Description

- Modifying the Florida’s Turnpike and Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) interchange to improve traffic flow
- Adding a new southbound Turnpike entrance ramp from eastbound Sunrise Boulevard and a new northbound Turnpike exit ramp from eastbound Sunrise Boulevard
- Removing the existing toll plaza at the northbound Turnpike entrance and converting all ramps to all-electronic tolling

On Sunrise Boulevard:

- Replacing and raising the existing bridge over the Turnpike
- Widening lanes between NW 56th Avenue and NW 47th Avenue
- Adding a bicycle lane on the north side of Sunrise Boulevard
- Adding an enclosed pedestrian walkway on the north side of the bridge

### Construction and Traffic Impacts

Florida’s Turnpike takes steps to reduce construction impacts. Travel lane closures and detours will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration and dust.

#### Schedule and Funding

##### Construction Schedule

Work is anticipated to be completed in 2020.

##### Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$50 million. This project is funded by toll and concession revenue.
