



## **PD&E Widen Turnpike SPUR & HEFT (Golden Glades-HEFT) & (NW 57th Ave.-Mainline) (FPID: 423373-1)**

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**JULY 2013**

### **Project Overview**

This is a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study that is evaluating alternatives to provide additional capacity to meet future traffic needs and improve safety along the Turnpike Extension, also known as the Homestead Extension of Florida's Turnpike (S.R. 821), and the Turnpike (S.R. 91) north of the Golden Glades interchange. This project will evaluate improvements to three interchanges at: NW 27th Avenue, Turnpike (S.R. 91/S.R. 821) and NW 199th Street/Stadium. Improvements to the signing, pavement markings, lighting, and drainage system will be investigated.

### **Construction Impacts**

At this time, the project alternatives are still being evaluated such that construction impacts are not yet known.

### **Schedule**

The PD&E Study is currently scheduled to be completed in the Summer of 2014.

### **Project Benefits**

Widening of the Turnpike and Turnpike Extension will provide additional capacity and safety improvements, as well as interchange improvements in the project area.
