



CR 468 Interchange at The Villages

Project Overview

The proposed project is a new interchange at the existing crossing of CR 468 over Florida's Turnpike in Sumter County, Florida. It will be located approximately five miles north of the CR 470 interchange and approximately four miles south of the US 301 interchange. CR 468 is a two-lane urban collector from US 301 to CR 501 and a two-lane rural major collector from CR 501 to SR 44. All right-of-way required for the project is being acquired by The Villages and donated to the Turnpike. The project is proposed to be built in two phases. Phase 1, to be constructed initially, will include the ramps to and from the south. Phase 2 will add the ramps to and from the north, along with related toll collection facilities.

Project Benefits

This new interchange at the existing crossing of CR 468 over Florida's Turnpike will serve the rapidly-growing tri-county area that includes northeastern Sumter County and adjacent areas in Lake and Marion Counties. The growth is largely attributed to the development of The Villages. This new interchange is vital for the continued economic growth and vitality of the community.

Investment

This project is funded entirely by The Villages, and final plans are expected in February 2014.
