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Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Holds Public 'Kick-Off' for Project Development and Environment Study on Sawgrass Expressway, Between US 441/SR 7 and Powerline Road in Broward County

FORT LAUDERDALE — Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a kick-off meeting for a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study for the Sawgrass Expressway between south of US 441 (SR 7) and Powerline Road (SR 845) in Broward County. The meeting will be held Tuesday, November 15, from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. in Coral Springs, Florida.

The PD&E Study will address existing and future traffic needs, improved travel time reliability, enhanced safety and long-term mobility options along this segment of the Sawgrass Expressway.

The kick-off meeting will be an informal style workshop, with transportation experts and numerous visual elements to help explain various phases of the PD&E process. Public input at the workshop will be collected via available comment forms.
