The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will hold a Public Information Meeting to present the design of a new tolled roadway from Polk Parkway (SR 570) at Winter Lake Road (SR 540) to US 17 (SR 35) in Polk County, Florida (Financial Project Identification Number 440897-2). The Public Information Meeting will be held on **Tuesday, June 18, 2019** at the **W.H. Stuart Center** located at **1710 US Highway 17 South, Bartow, FL 33830**. The meeting will be an informal open house from **5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.** A copy of the project location map is included below. There will be no formal presentation. In the event that the Public Information Meeting cannot be held on June 18, 2019 due to severe weather or other unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate date of July 9, 2019 at the same time and place.

During the open house, displays illustrating the proposed design will be available for review. Information about Right-of-Way needs, project schedule and potential environmental impacts will be on display. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise representatives will be available to discuss the project and answer questions.
