### DISTRICT SIX PROJECT OVERVIEW

In FY 2019 and FY 2020, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise funded various major transportation infrastructure improvements in District Six. Notable projects include:

- Widen the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 from the Dolphin Expressway / SR 836 to NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard (FPN: 435543-1)
- Widen the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 from NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard to I-75 (FPN: 435542-1)

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise continues to make project investments in District Six. In FY 2021 through FY 2025, Turnpike projects total over \$175 million within Miami-Dade County.

**Widen the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 from the Dolphin Expressway / SR 836 (MP 26) to NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard (MP 34)**  
**FPN: 435543-1**

The project widens a segment of the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 between the Dolphin Expressway / SR 836 and NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard. The project will increase the number of travel lanes from six/eight to ten and will include express lanes. Express lanes implementation is planned upon completion of all widening projects on the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 between the Dolphin Expressway / SR 836 (MP 26) and Miramar Plaza (MP 47). Construction began in FY 2019 and the FY 2022 funding reflects the remaining cost to complete the project. Work includes milling and resurfacing, guardrail installation, and signing and pavement marking improvements.

**Widen the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 from NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard (MP 34) to I-75 (MP 39)**  
**FPN: 435542-1**

The project widens a segment of the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 from NW 106th Street / Flagler Station Boulevard to I-75. The project will increase the number of travel lanes from six to ten and will include express lanes. Express lanes implementation is planned upon completion of all widening projects on the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 between the Dolphin Expressway / SR 836 (MP 26) and Miramar Plaza (MP 47). Construction is scheduled to begin in FY 2020 and the FY 2022 funding reflects the remaining cost to complete the project. Work includes milling and resurfacing, guardrail installation, and signing and pavement marking improvements.

**Interchange Improvements on the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 at Hainlin Mill Drive / SW 216th Street (MP 11)**  
**Surface Street Improvements from Hainlin Mill Drive / SW 216th Street (MP 11) to US 1 (MP 12)**  
**FPN: 437211-1**

The project increases operational capacity, improves safety, addresses roadway and structural deficiencies, and enhances overall traffic operations on the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 at Hainlin Mill Drive / SW 216th Street interchange. The project also includes improvements along the Turnpike Extension / SR 821 and surface streets between Hainlin Mill Drive / SW 216th Street and US 1. This includes funding for FPN: 443882-1 which goes with this project. Work includes implementation of express lanes from MP 5 to MP 12, and bridge deck rehabilitation.

**Widen the Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 Spur from Golden Glades Toll Plaza (MP 0.4) to Miami-Dade / Broward County Line (MP 3.3)**  
**FPN: 423373-5**

The project widens a segment of the Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 Spur from Golden Glades Toll Plaza to Miami-Dade / Broward County Line. The project will increase the number of travel lanes from six to eight, and includes infrastructure improvements to accommodate the future implementation of express lanes. Work includes milling and resurfacing, guardrail installation, and signing and pavement marking improvements.
