



All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Project Phase 6C Suncoast Parkway from Van Dyke Road to US 98

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is converting Suncoast Parkway/State Road (SR) 589 to all-electronic tolling (AET), from Van Dyke Road to US 98, providing non-stop travel to customers who travel the Suncoast Parkway.

Cash toll collections will be removed at the following sites once the new electronic tolling sites open:

- Spring Hill Toll Plaza (Milepost 31)
- CR 578 (Exit 37)
- SR 50/Cortez Boulevard (Exit 46)
- Oak Hammock Toll Plaza (Milepost 53)

This project also includes installing new toll gantries, toll equipment buildings, asphalt milling and resurfacing and lighting, drainage and utilities improvements.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
