



All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Conversion Project on Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from Kissimmee Park Road to Interstate 75

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is converting this section of the Mainline to All-Electronic Tolling (AET). This project covers 70 miles of the Turnpike from mileposts 239 (south of Kissimmee Park Road) to I-75.

This project includes the following improvements:

- Milling and resurfacing
- Minor road widening
- Lighting, highway signage, and guardrail improvements
- Toll Facilities construction

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and Central West Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

The project cost is approximately \$17.5 million.
