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Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

Ocoee, Fla. – [Florida's Turnpike Enterprise](#) announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Central Florida beginning Sunday, July 12. Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM THE LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THE THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA (MILEPOSTS 88-236)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from north of Canoe Creek Service Plaza to Three Lakes Toll Plaza (Milepost 236)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 12, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 13.

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, July 13, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the conversion of the Florida's Turnpike to an All-Electronic Tolling (AET) collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. The overall AET conversion scope includes the installation of 12 new AET gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs (DMS).

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING & ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA TO KISSIMMEE PARK ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Three Lakes Toll Plaza and Kissimmee Park Road Mileposts 234 to 238)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 8 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Resurfacing and roadside improvements on the Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from the Three Lakes Toll Plaza to Kissimmee Park Road (milepost 234-238). This project also includes improvements to guardrails, signing and

pavement markings. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$6.5 million and construction is expected to be completed in fall 2020.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309)
OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE & SUMTER COUNTIES

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT
ON NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM KISSIMMEE PARK ROAD TO
INTERSTATE 75 (MILEPOST 236 TO MILEPOST 309)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 just south of the Leesburg Plaza (Mileposts 285 to 287)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, July 13, and nightly through Friday, July 17.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Kissimmee Park Road (Exit 240)

Overnight full ramp closure, 11 p.m. Monday, July 13, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 14.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 11 p.m. Tuesday, July 14, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, July 15; and 11 p.m. Wednesday, July 15, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 16.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Kissimmee Park Road (Exit 240) will be directed to exit at Kissimmee/St. Cloud/US 192/US 441 (Exit 244), travel east on US 192 to Old Canoe Creek Road and travel south on Old Canoe Creek Road access Kissimmee Park Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The overall AET conversion scope includes: milling and resurfacing, minor widening, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from south of Kissimmee Park Road (milepost 236) to I-75 (milepost 309) for 70 miles in Osceola, Orange, Lake and Sumter counties. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$17.5 million and work will continue through spring 2021.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM OSCEOLA PARKWAY TO BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY & TOLL 417 RAMPS

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Osceola Parkway and Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Mileposts 249 to 255)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

Northbound and southbound Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 between US 17/US 92/US 441 and south of Landstar Boulevard (Mileposts 11 to 13)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from four to eight lanes, between Osceola Parkway and the Beachline Expressway/SR 528. The project includes constructing three ramps at the SR 417 interchange: northbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417; southbound Florida's Turnpike to northbound SR 417; and southbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417. Other improvements are widening and/or reconstructing ramps at the Osceola Parkway and Orlando South interchanges, replacing the Florida's Turnpike bridges over the Central Florida Rail corridor and Central Florida Parkway, and replacing the roadway overpasses at Orange Avenue and Taft-Vineland Road. The approximate cost is \$176 million. The project is expected to be completed in 2021.

I-4 DIRECT CONNECT RAMPS TO NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 AND IMPROVEMENTS FROM BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY TO I-4 (MILEPOSTS 253-261)

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 254) and south of the I-4 Interchange (Exit 259)

Long-term single lane closure through December 31, 2020. Three lanes will remain open to traffic.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4, just north of the toll plaza

Long-term single ramp lane closure through December 31, 2020. One access ramp lane will remain open to traffic.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 255) and I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight double lane closure, 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4

Overnight full ramp closure, 8 p.m. Sunday, July 12, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 13.

If necessary, this closure may also occur 8 p.m. Monday, July 13, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, July 14.

Detour information:

- I-4 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77) and follow signs for South Turnpike Miami, travel south on Florida's Turnpike to Consulate Drive (Exit 255), travel east on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing flyover ramps to directly connect the Florida's Turnpike to and from I-4. This project includes constructing six new all-electronic tolling points, removing three existing ramp tolling points, milling, and resurfacing from south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road, and improving signalization at Consulate Drive. Other improvements include barrier and guardrail installation, highway lighting drainage and signage. This \$85 million project is expected to be completed in 2021.

TURKEY LAKE SERVICE PLAZA TANDEM TRUCK STAGING LOT

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 just south of the Turkey Lake Service Plaza (Milepost 262 to 263.5)

Daytime shoulder closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing a new tandem truck staging lot at the southside of Florida Turnpike's Turkey Lake Service Plaza in Orange County. The project will replace the existing tandem truck staging lot at Florida's Turnpike and Interstate 4. This project will include lighting, signing, striping, landscaping and irrigation improvements for the new staging lot and drainage improvements along southbound Florida's Turnpike mainline. The cost for this project is approximately \$4.95 million and it is expected to be completed in spring 2021.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 WIDENING FROM ECONLOCKHATCHEE TRAIL TO ALOMA AVENUE

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 from just north of Aloma Avenue to Seminole/Orange County Line

Overnight single lane closure, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 entrance ramp from Aloma Avenue

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 12, to 5 a.m. Monday, July 13; and 10 p.m. Monday, July 13, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, July 14.

If necessary, this closure may also occur from 10 p.m. Tuesday, July 14, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, July 15; and 10 p.m. Wednesday, July 15, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 16.

Detour information:

- Aloma Avenue/SR 426 traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 will be directed to Red Bug Lake Road and travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to access southbound Seminole Expressway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/SR 417 is being widened from four to six lanes between Econlockhatchee Trail and Aloma Avenue in a collaborative project between Florida's Turnpike Enterprise and Central Florida Expressway Authority. Improvements include additional auxiliary lanes between Aloma Avenue and University Boulevard to alleviate congestion, realignment of the northbound off-ramp to Aloma Avenue, asphalt milling and resurfacing, new signage, and safety upgrades. The approximate cost is \$44.8 million. The project is expected to be completed in 2020.

Overnight partial lane closure, 10:30 p.m. Tuesday, July 14, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, July 15.

Eastbound and westbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 from I-4 to Jetport Drive/McCoy Road (Mileposts 0 to 8)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PHASE 6C
FROM VAN DYKE ROAD TO US 98 (MILEPOSTS 14 - 55)**

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Anclote Toll Gantry (Milepost 21)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Anclote Toll Gantry (Milepost 21)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Spring Hill Toll Gantry (Milepost 31)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Spring Hill Toll Gantry (Milepost 31)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

Northbound and southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 at Oak Hammock Toll Gantry (Milepost 49)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, July 12, and nightly through Thursday, July 16.
Daytime single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Thursday, July 16.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This \$30 million improvement project will convert the section of highway between Van Dyke Road and US 98 to all-electronic tolling (AET), providing non-stop travel to customers who travel the Suncoast Parkway. This conversion project includes gantry foundation installation, toll plaza equipment buildings, asphalt milling/resurfacing, roadway widening at the new gantry locations, lighting, drainage, utilities, and demolition.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY 2/SR 589
FROM US 98 TO SR 44**

Eastbound and westbound US 98 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Long-term single lane closures. One lane in each direction will remain open to traffic.

W. Oak Park Boulevard/CR 480 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Possible daytime intermittent single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Friday, July 17.

W. Cardinal Street in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Possible daytime intermittent single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday, July 13, and daily through Friday, July 17.

Detour information:

- S. Pine Meadow Avenue traffic wishing to access W. Cardinal Street should travel north on S. Pine Meadow Avenue to W. Mockingbird Street, travel west on W. Mockingbird Street to S. Eastern Avenue and travel south on S. Eastern Avenue to access W. Cardinal Street.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing the Suncoast Parkway 2, a four-lane toll facility that extends the existing Suncoast Parkway northward for 13 miles from US 98, in Hernando County, to SR 44, in Citrus County. Work includes constructing full interchanges at US 98 and W. Cardinal Street, a partial interchange at SR 44, a wildlife crossing and four wildlife culverts, 15 new bridges, and related drainage, lighting, highway signing, traffic signalization, guardrail, and sidewalk. The Suncoast Trail, part of Florida's Statewide Greenways and Trails System, will also be extended from US 98 to SR 44, with a pedestrian overpass constructed over US 98. The approximate cost is \$135 million and is expected to be completed in 2022.

**POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO WESTERN TOLL PLAZA**

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 from I-4 to just west of Airport Road (Mileposts 0 to 2)

Continuous single lane closure, 7 p.m. Sunday, July 12, to 7 a.m. Saturday, July 18.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Resurfacing and roadside improvements on Polk Parkway from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (milepost 0-8). This project also includes improvements to bridge joints, guardrails, signing, drainage, and pavement markings. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$13.5 million and construction is expected to be completed in spring 2021.

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
