

Widen Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) From Palm Beach County Line to north of Glades Road FPID: 418214-1

Project Description

This project widens the Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from the Palm Beach County Line to north of Glades Road / SR 808. This widening will increase the number of travel lanes from six to ten with one managed lane in each direction. This project includes pavement reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, bridge improvements, stormwater drainage improvements and noise walls in qualifying areas. Interchange improvements at Glades Road / SR 808 are also being evaluated through a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study.


The project limits also include a Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSM&O) Project (FPID 418214-5), to extend the northbound and southbound travel through lanes from the Palm Beach County line to north of Glades Road / SR 808.

Project Status

The widening project is in Design that will only progress to Phase I to support the TSM&O Project that will be constructed first.

Construction for the widening is not funded.

The TSM&O project is funded for Design in Fiscal Year 2021, with Construction funded in Fiscal Year 2024.
