

Widen Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 From Indiantown Road to Okeechobee Road (SR 70) FPID: 423374-1

Project Description

This project is a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for Florida's Turnpike from Jupiter (Indiantown Road) to Okeechobee Road (SR 70), in Palm Beach, Martin and St. Lucie Counties, Florida.

The project consists of widening the Turnpike by adding two general toll lanes in each direction (4 total lanes in each direction). Numerous bridge structures will be widened or reconstructed along with the roadway.

The project corridor includes crossings of the Loxahatchee River and St. Lucie Canal. Potential reconfiguration of existing interchanges and new interchange access locations will also be considered as part of the PD&E study.
