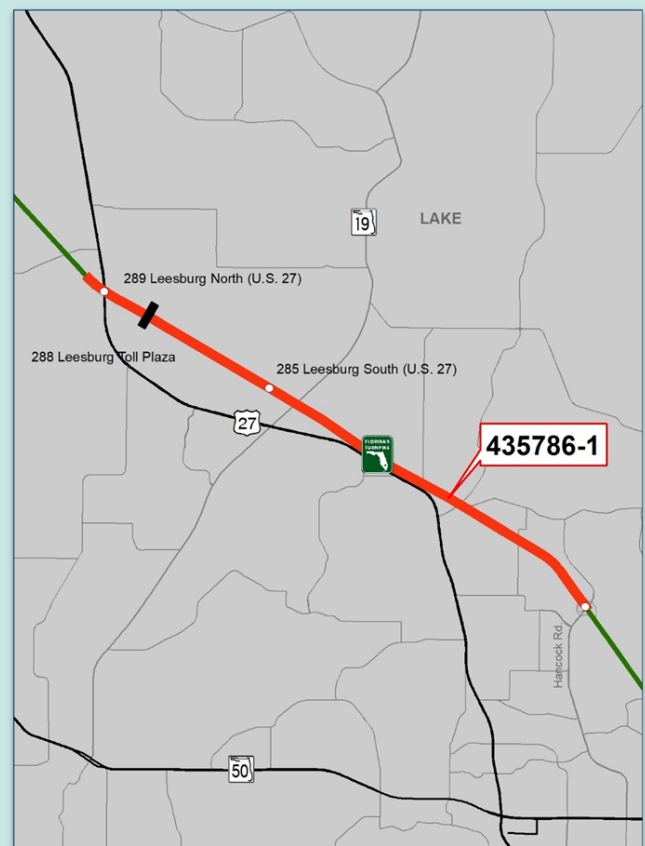


Widen Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from Minneola to US 27 FPID: 435786-1

Project Description

The project widens a ten-mile segment of the Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from the Minneola interchange to the US 27 interchange in Lake County. The widening will increase the number of travel lanes from four to eight.

Construction includes pavement widening, milling and resurfacing, maintenance of traffic plan, new stormwater treatment facilities, new bridge structures (Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, US 27 / SR 19 (South), Obrien Road, and US 27 / SR 19 (North), new tolling sites, signing, pavement marking improvements, lighting, intelligent traffic system (ITS) signalization, right-of-way acquisition, and interchange improvements at US 27 / SR 19 (MP 285) (new ramps to and from the north) and US 27 / SR 19 (MP 289).



Project Status

This project is in Design.

Right-of-Way is funded in Fiscal Years 2021, 2022 and 2023.

Construction is funded in Fiscal Year 2023.
