



Replacing Crash Cushions throughout Florida's Turnpike System

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is replacing crash cushions and removing median crossovers in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Hillsborough, Lake and Osceola counties.

This project includes crash cushion upgrades, median barrier wall construction and shoulder resurfacing throughout select locations along the following roadways:

- Florida's Turnpike Extension/State Road (SR) 821
- Southern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91
- Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91
- Veteran's Expressway/SR 589
- Southern Connector Extension/SR 417

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
