Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 ON CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM THE LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THE THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA (MILEPOSTS 88-236)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from north of Canoe Creek Service Plaza to Three Lakes Toll Plaza (Milepost 236)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 10, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 11.
Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 11, and nightly through Thursday, January 14.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Work consists of providing all labor, materials, equipment, and incidentals necessary for the conversion of the Florida's Turnpike to an All-Electronic Tolling (AET) collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. The overall AET conversion scope includes the installation of 12 new AET gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs (DMS).

ALL-ELECTRONIC TOLLING (AET) CONVERSION PROJECT
ON NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 FROM KISSIMMEE PARK ROAD TO
INTERSTATE 75 (MILEPOST 236 TO MILEPOST 309)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 just south of the Leesburg Plaza
(Mileposts 285 to 287)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 10, and nightly through Friday, January 15.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, December 14, and daily through Friday, January 15.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Winter Garden/Clermont/SR 50 (Exit 272)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The overall AET conversion scope includes milling and resurfacing, minor widening, lighting, highway signing, guardrail, toll facilities and other construction activities on the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from south of Kissimmee Park Road (milepost 236) to I-75 (milepost 309) for 70 miles in Osceola, Orange, Lake and Sumter counties. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$17.5 million and work will continue through spring 2021.

**NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM OSCEOLA PARKWAY TO BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY & TOLL SR 417 RAMPS**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Osceola Parkway and Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Mileposts 249 to 255)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 10, and nightly through Thursday, January 14.

Northbound and southbound Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 between US 17/US 92/US 441 and Landstar Boulevard (Mileposts 11 to 14)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 10, and nightly through Thursday, January 14.

Northbound Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 exit ramp to northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 12)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. Wednesday, January 13, to 6 a.m., Thursday, January 14; and 9:30 p.m. Thursday, January 14, to 6 a.m. Friday, January 15.

Detour information:

- Northbound Central Florida GreeneWay/SR 417 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Exit 12) will be directed to exit at Orange Blossom Trail/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 11) and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening the Northern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from four to eight lanes, between Osceola Parkway and the Beachline Expressway/SR 528. The project includes constructing three ramps at the SR 417 interchange: northbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417; southbound Florida's Turnpike to northbound SR 417; and southbound Florida's Turnpike to southbound SR 417. Other improvements are widening and/or reconstructing ramps at the Osceola Parkway and Orlando South interchanges, replacing the Florida's Turnpike bridges over the Central Florida Rail corridor and Central Florida Parkway, and replacing the roadway overpasses at Orange Avenue and Taft-Vineland Road. The approximate cost is \$176 million. The project is expected to be completed in 2021.

**I-4 DIRECT CONNECT RAMPS TO NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 AND
IMPROVEMENTS FROM BEACHLINE EXPRESSWAY TO I-4 (MILEPOSTS 253-261)**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 254) and south of the I-4 Interchange (Exit 259)

Long-term single lane closure through September 1, 2021. Three lanes will remain open to traffic.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4, just north of the toll plaza

Long-term single lane closure through April 31, 2021. One lane will remain open to traffic.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (Exit 255) and I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, January 10, and nightly through Thursday, January 14.

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Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from I-4

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 10, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 11, and nightly through Wednesday, January 13.

Detour information:

- I-4 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to exit at Florida's Turnpike (Exit 77) and follow signs for South Turnpike Miami, travel south on Florida's Turnpike to Consulate Drive (Exit 255), travel east on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441 and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to I-4 (Exit 259)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Monday, January 11, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, January 12; and Tuesday, January 12, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, January 13.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to access I-4 will be directed to exit at Consulate Drive (Exit 255), travel east on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to northbound Florida's Turnpike and travel north on Florida's Turnpike to access I-4 (Exit 259).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is constructing flyover ramps to directly connect the Florida's Turnpike to and from I-4. This project includes constructing six new all-electronic tolling points, removing three existing ramp tolling points, milling, and resurfacing from south of Orange Blossom Trail to Vineland Road, and improving signalization at Consulate Drive. Other improvements include barrier and guardrail installation, highway lighting drainage and signage. This \$85 million project is expected to be completed in 2021.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS FROM MILEPOST 260 TO MILEPOST 265

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 between north of Interstate 4 and south of SR 408 (mileposts 260 to 265), in Orange County. This project includes reconstruction of the FTE headquarters' parking lot, landscaping, and lighting upgrades. The project cost is \$18.9 million and is expected to be completed in summer 2022.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 RESURFACING FROM MILEPOST 38 TO MILEPOST 45

Northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 at Aloma Avenue (Milepost 38)

Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 exit ramp to SR 434 (Exit 44)

Detour information:

- Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 traffic wishing to access SR 434 (Exit 44) will be directed to exit at Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 41), travel east on Red Bug Lake Road/W. Mitchell Hammock Road to Alafaya Trail and travel north on Alafaya Trail/S. Central Avenue to access SR 434.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is resurfacing the existing asphalt roadway for the Seminole Expressway/State Road (SR) 417 between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and SR 434, in Seminole County. Improvements include median modifications, shoulder reconstruction, and new signage. It is estimated the project will cost \$12.9 million and construction is expected to be completed in 2021.

Eastbound and westbound US 98 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Long-term single lane closures. One lane in each direction will remain open to traffic.

W. Oak Park Boulevard/CR 480 in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

Possible daytime intermittent single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, January 11, and daily through Friday, January 15.

W. Cardinal Street in the vicinity of the Suncoast Parkway/SR 589

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike Enterprise is constructing the Suncoast Parkway 2, a four-lane toll facility that extends the existing Suncoast Parkway northward for 13 miles from US 98, in Hernando County, to SR 44, in Citrus County. Work includes constructing full interchanges at US 98 and W. Cardinal Street, a partial interchange at SR 44, a wildlife crossing and four wildlife culverts, 15 new bridges, and related drainage, lighting, highway signing, traffic signalization, guardrail, and sidewalk. The Suncoast Trail, part of Florida’s Statewide Greenways and Trails System, will also be extended from US 98 to SR 44, with a pedestrian overpass constructed over US 98. The approximate cost is \$135 million and is expected to be completed in 2022.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida’s Turnpike Enterprise is installing new drainage systems on Veteran’s Expressway/SR 589 from Linebaugh Avenue to Wilsky Boulevard (mileposts 7.2 to 8.2) and from Ehrlich Road to Van Dyke Road (mileposts 10.8 to 14.2), in Hillsborough County. Construction will continue through 2021. Approximate cost: \$2.5 million.

**POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO WESTERN TOLL PLAZA**

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 from Waring Road to Airport Road (Mileposts 4 to 3)

Continuous single lane closure, 7 a.m. Tuesday, January 12, to 5 p.m. Thursday, January 14.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 from Clark Road to exit ramp to westbound I-4 (Mileposts 1 to 0.5)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Resurfacing and roadside improvements on Polk Parkway from Interstate 4 to the Western Toll Plaza (milepost 0-8). This project also includes improvements to bridge joints, guardrails, signing, drainage, and pavement markings. It is anticipated that the project will cost \$13.5 million and construction is expected to be completed in spring 2021.
