



Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project from Milepost 117 to Milepost 138

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is resurfacing Central Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 from north of SR 706/Indiantown Road (milepost 117) to south of Becker Road (milepost 138), in Martin County.

This project includes the following improvements:

- Asphalt milling and resurfacing the mainline
- Resurfacing the following ramps:
 - Northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 714/Martin Highway/Stuart (Exit 133)
 - Northbound and southbound entrance ramps from SR 714/Martin Highway/Stuart
- Signing and pavement markings

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Work is anticipated to be completed in fall 2022.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$34 million.
