



Central Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Widening Project from North of Boynton Beach Boulevard to North of Lake Worth Road

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is widening the Central Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 from two to three lanes in each direction, between the Lantana Toll Plaza and the West Palm Beach Service Plaza.

This project includes the following improvements:

- Shifting Central Turnpike Mainline between Boynton Beach Boulevard and Lake Worth Road to the west to avoid utility conflicts
- Reconstructing Hypoluxo Road bridge over the Turnpike to allow new road configuration
- Improving signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage
- Constructing sound walls along qualifying residential areas adjacent to Central Turnpike Mainline

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

If lane closures are necessary, they will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work began in 2019 and is expected to be completed in summer 2025.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$170 million.

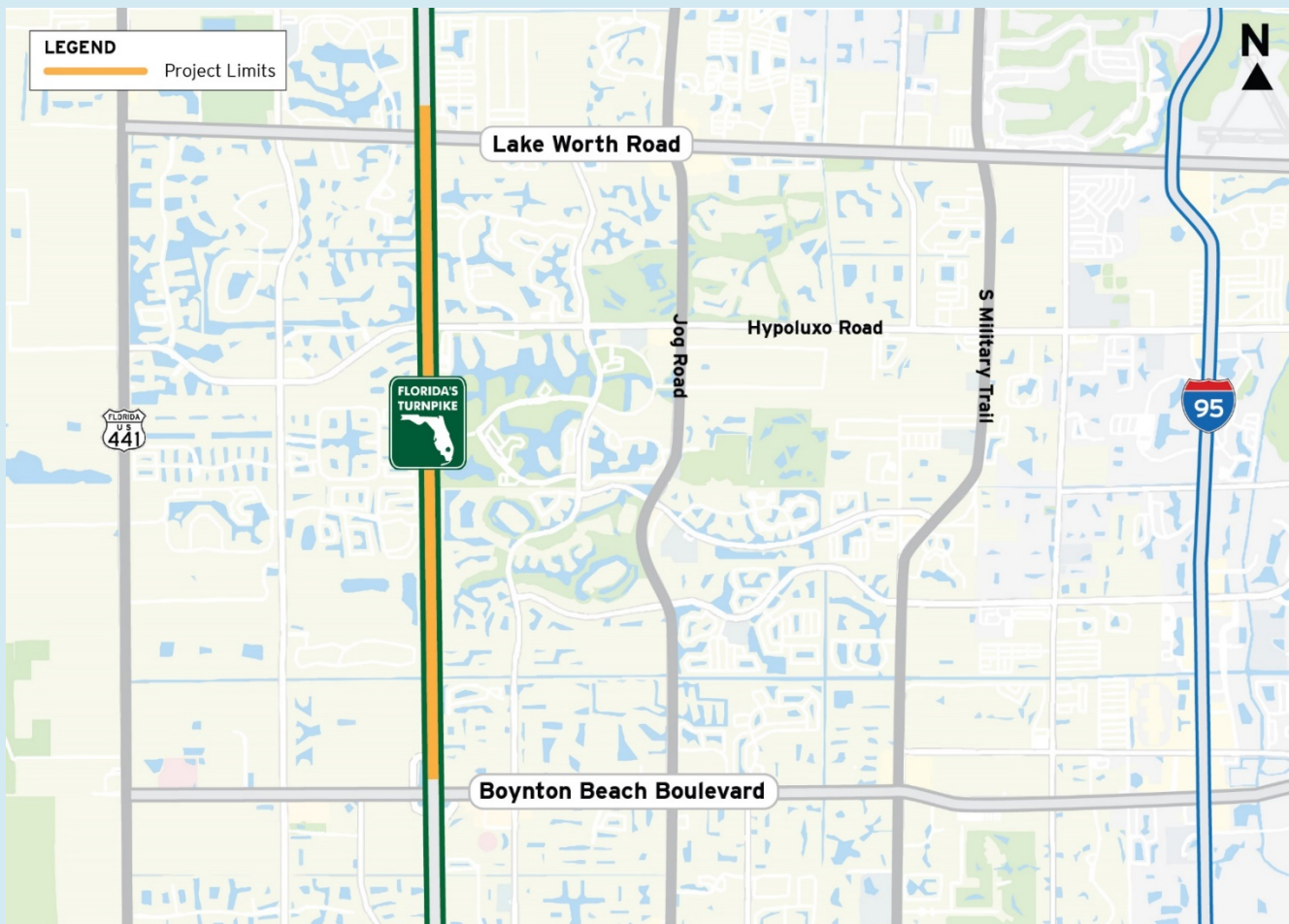
