



## All-Electronic Tolling (AET) Installation Project Southern Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 at Hard Rock Stadium Interchange

### Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) is modifying the Southern Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 and Hard Rock Stadium Interchange in Miami-Dade County.

This project includes the following improvements:

- Constructing new tolling points, along with signing and pavement marking modifications, to accommodate new tolling equipment and toll gantry structures
- Demolishing the existing Hard Rock Stadium Interchange Toll Plaza canopy and booths, as well as the concrete pavement

### Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. FTE takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

#### Schedule and Funding

##### Construction Schedule

Work began in 2020 and is anticipated to be completed in summer 2021.

##### Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$5.3 million.
