



The barrier is intended to obstruct view into the SunTrax facility. Work will require selective clearing & grubbing, and regular coordination with nearby SunTrax construction activities and the adjacent widening of Polk Parkway between mileposts 17 – 24.


SR 54 OPERATIONAL RAMP IMPROVEMENTS (SR 589) INTERCHANGE (MP 19)



WRONG WAY DETECTION TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION - SOUTH FLA & POWER SYSTEM HARDENING FOR ITS

INFRASTRUCTURE — This CEI contract is intended to administer two separate ITS projects, with an anticipated contract execution in August 2021. The Wrong Way Detection Implementation of South Florida will be design-build, with an anticipated project duration of 30 months. Work will involve 45 ramp locations, on the Turnpike mainline between Sunrise Blvd and PGA Blvd, Turnpike Extension/SR 821 between mileposts 1—13, and Sawgrass Expressway between mileposts 1—19. The second contract, Power Hardening for ITS Infrastructures, will be a design-bid-build with a construction duration of 6 months. Work will involve installation of new generators & their associated facilities, to prevent outages at 25 selected Power Distribution Subsystems. Work will include locations on the HEFT/SR 821, Turnpike Mainline/SR 91, Boynton Beach Blvd/SR 804, and Seminole Expressway/SR 417.

MBE / DBE CERTIFICATION



MBE Requirements

The Corporation must -

- Be registered and based in Florida
- Be owned and managed by a Florida resident
- Be 51% managed, owned and control by a woman, veteran or minority
- Be engaged in Commercial Transactions
- Be registered in MyFloridaMarketplace
- Have a net worth less than \$5 million
- Have 200 or fewer full-time employees
- Have a professional license if required in the name of the woman, veteran or minority.

DBE Requirements

The Corporation must –

- Be 51% managed, owned and controlled by a minority
- Have an owner possessing expertise in work specialty
- Have Net Worth less than \$1.32M (excluding business & primary residence)
- Have annual gross revenues less than
 \$22.4M in the previous three fiscal periods
- Be an independent business entity whose viability does not depend on relationships with other firms
